A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A SECOND AMENDMENT AND ISSUE A BLANKET PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH SOUTH BROWARD HOSPITAL DISTRICT D/B/A MEMORIAL HEALTHCARE SYSTEM FOR MEDICAL SUPPLIES IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT UP TO \$285,000.00 FOR A THREE-YEAR PERIOD IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(9) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE. (BEST INTEREST)

WHEREAS, the provision of emergency services by the Fire Rescue and Beach Safety Department ("Department") requires the purchase of medical supplies vital to its operation in accordance with the Department's State of Florida Emergency Medical License; and

WHEREAS, South Broward Hospital District d/b/a Memorial Healthcare System ("Memorial") has been a trusted provider for over 25 years, consistently providing the Department with high-quality medical supplies at the lowest available costs and with superior product availability; and

WHEREAS, Memorial is easily accessible by the Department for any of the required medical supplies; and

WHEREAS, the period of performance during which the desired medical supplies will be acquired is for a three-year period for an annual amount up to \$95,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Memorial utilizes the same Florida Regional EMS protocols as the City's emergency service units and supplies are available immediately; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(9) of the Procurement Code states that when the City Commission declares by a five-sevenths (5/7ths) affirmative vote that competitive bidding and competitive proposals are not in the best interest of the City, such purchases are exempt from competitive bidding and competitive proposal requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Department wishes to execute a Second Amendment To Letter Agreement ("Amendment") and issue a Blanket Purchase Agreement for an additional three-year period, during which the desired medical supplies will be acquired from August 27, 2025, through August 26, 2028; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief and Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City

Commission approve and authorize the execution of a Blanket Purchase Agreement with Memorial for medical supplies in an annual amount up to \$95,000.00; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the funding for this Blanket Purchase Agreement is available Operating Budget FΥ 2025 in account in the number 001.215101.52200.552320.000000.000.000 and will be budgeted in subsequent fiscal years' operating budgets subject to approval and adoption by the City Commission. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed Section 1: as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution. That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached Second Amendment and Blanket Purchase Agreement to Memorial, together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.
