Adam Reichbach, Assistant City Manager for Finance and Administration, gave a presentation on the proposed FY2024 budget.

[R-2023-285](#) A Resolution Of The City Commission Of The City Of Hollywood, Florida, Relating To The Provision Of Fire Rescue Services, Facilities And Programs In The City Of Hollywood, Florida; Reimposing Fire Rescue Assessments Against Assessed Property Located Within The City Of Hollywood, Florida, For The Fiscal Year Beginning October 1, 2023; Approving The Rate Of Assessment; Approving The Assessment Roll.

A Resolution Of The City Commission Of The City Of Hollywood, Florida, Tentatively Fixing The Amount And Rate Of Taxation For The Fiscal Year Commencing October 1, 2023, And Making The Tax Levy For The Year 2023.

The Mayor read the title of the Resolution: "A Resolution Of The City Commission Of The City Of Hollywood, Florida, Tentatively Fixing The Amount And Rate Of Taxation For The Fiscal Year Commencing October 1, 2023, And Making The Tax Levy For The Year 2023."

The Mayor stated "The Proposed Maximum Millage Rate Set By The City Commission Of The City Of Hollywood On July 5, 2023 Is 7.4665 Mills. At This Time, The City Manager Is Proposing That The Millage Rate Be

Tentatively Set At 7.4665, Which Is Estimated To Generate General Fund Net Revenues Of One Hundred Sixty-Seven Million, Twenty Thousand, Nine Hundred And Forty-Seven Dollars (\$167,020,947.00). This Millage Rate Represents A 10.74% Increase Over The Rolled-Back Rate Of 6.7425 Mills."

The Mayor announced the resolution was advertised in conformance with Florida Statutes and City Codes and opened the public hearing. Ann Ralston, 326 S 14th Avenue, expressed personal opinions/concerns. There being no one further who wished to speak, the public hearing was declared closed.
