

**Justice Michael Kiziah Chin** was born on July 8, 1996 at Memorial Regional Hospital on Johnson Street in Hollywood, FL — the same place he would prematurely pass away 25 years later...but not before donating all of his organs, thereby saving and improving countless lives.

That alone, in our minds, warrants an acknowledgement from a grateful city. However, before giving that beautiful gift of life, Justice himself *lived* a beautiful life — one that exemplified the sense of community every local government seeks to cultivate in the place they call home. We know that is especially true for the City of Hollywood, FL whose mission is to provide a thriving community where quality living is available to all.

Justice was born in Hollywood, attended school (preschool through high school graduation) in Hollywood, fell in love in Hollywood, worked at the family plumbing business in Hollywood, and, above all else, Justice skateboarded in Hollywood. He skateboarded so, so much in his hometown. And his favorite place to do so was at the skatepark at Stanley Goldman Memorial Park where Justice was a friend to everyone he encountered. Everyone.

For this reason, we believe the skatepark at Stanley Goldman Memorial Park should be named **Justice Skatepark**.

Let's give the youth of Hollywood the skatepark they deserve, and let's name it after the young man who always showed them what community is all about. Consider this: every time a new skater sees that sign, reads Justice's name, and asks, "Who was he? Why was he so special?" the veteran skater can tell him: "Justice was a really cool and hilarious guy. He was a talented skater, a hero, and a beloved member of our skatepark community. C'mon in and join our community."
