A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD AND THE SHERIFF OF BROWARD COUNTY ("BSO") FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SOUTH FLORIDA INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN OPERATIONAL TASK FORCE.

WHEREAS, various law enforcement agencies from Broward County municipalities have joined together in a multi-agency task force intended to combat crimes committed against children and the criminal exploitation of children that is committed and/or facilitated by or through the use of computers, and to disrupt and dismantle organizations engaging in such activity; and

WHEREAS, the Broward Sheriff's Office is the recipient of a federal grant disbursed by the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention in Washington, D.C. to assist law enforcement in investigating and combating the exploitation of children which occurs through the use of computers by providing funding for equipment, training, and expenses, including travel and overtime funding, which are incurred by law enforcement as a result of such investigations; and

WHEREAS, as such, each of the law enforcement agencies are required to execute the attached Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") in order to implement the task force and pursue its goals and mission as set forth in the MOU; and

WHEREAS, the attached MOU requires each law enforcement agency to assume its own liability and responsibility as well as requires indemnification to the extent permitted by law; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police for the City of Hollywood recommends that the City Commission authorize the appropriate City Officials to execute the attached MOU between the Sheriff of Broward County and the City of Hollywood;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That it hereby approves and authorizes the appropriate City Officials to execute the attached Memorandum of Understanding for the South Florida Internet Crimes Against Children Operational Task Force between the City of Hollywood and Broward County, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 2</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
