SUBJECT: Proposed Purchase Order with Integrity Municipal Systems, LLC. to

furnish and supply two in-kind replacement lime slaker units (No. 2 and

No. 3) at the Water Treatment Plant.

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I have discussed the above Agreement with the participating Department/Office, and the proposed general business terms and other significant ant provisions are as follows:

1) Department/Division involved – Public Utilities

- 2) Type of Agreement Purchase order (**Best Interest**).
- Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) Pursuant to Section 38.41(C)(9) of the City's Procurement Code, the City Commission may, when in the best interests of the City, by a 5/7ths affirmative vote, waive competitive bidding and competitive proposal requirements for the purchase of, and contracts for, supplies or services.
- 4) Term of Contract
  - a) initial one time purchase
  - b) renewals (if any) n/a
  - c) who exercises option to renew n/a
- 5) Contract Amount In an amount not to exceed \$332,000.00.
- 6) Termination rights City may terminate for cause.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Contractor shall comply with applicable City requirements set forth in the purchase order terms and conditions.
- 8) Scope of Services Contractor to provide 2 in-kind replacement lime slaker units at the water treatment plant.
- 9) Other significant provisions a) Seller provides a limited warranty on the equipment; b) Seller is not liable for consequential, incidental, special, punitive or other indirect damages, and its total liability shall not exceed the purchase price of \$332,000.00, however, such limitation does not apply to any claims which vendor is responsible pursuant to the indemnification provision.
