SCREENINGS AND TREATMENTS; AND

WHEREAS, CERVICAL CANCER MOST OFTEN AFFECTS WOMEN IN THE PRIME OF LIFE. IT IS A

DISEASE THAT STRIKES OVER 14,100 AMERICAN WOMEN EACH YEAR. IN FLORIDA, AN ESTIMATED 1,030 WOMEN WERE DIAGNOSED WITH INVASIVE CERVICAL CANCER, AND

ALMOST 300 WOMEN DIE EACH YEAR IN FLORIDA OF CERVICAL CANCER; AND

WHEREAS, IF A MOTHER OR SISTER HAS CERVICAL CANCER, A WOMAN'S CHANCES OF DEVELOPING

THE DISEASE INCREASES BY TWO TO THREE TIMES. REGULAR CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING TESTS ARE EFFECTIVE IN DETECTING THE DISEASE EARLY WHEN IT CAN BE

EFFECTIVELY TREATED; AND

WHEREAS, CERVICAL CANCER DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACTS VULNERABLE COMMUNITIES

LACKING ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE AND PROVEN LIFE-SAVING TOOLS. CERVICAL CANCER VACCINES ARE AVAILABLE THAT - TOGETHER WITH SCREENING TESTS -

PROVIDE A FORMIDABLE AND EFFECTIVE MEANS OF PREVENTING THIS DISEASE; AND

WHEREAS, INCREASING AWARENESS AMONG PATIENTS AND HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS ALIKE

REGARDING THE BEST USE OF THESE PREVENTION TOOLS IS A KEY COMPONENT IS

SAFE-GUARDING WOMEN'S HEALTH: AND
