A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BLUE LINE SOLUTIONS, LLC FOR AN AUTOMATED SCHOOL ZONE SAFETY SYSTEM, SERVICES, AND RELATED EQUIPMENT IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$0.00 OVER A TWO-YEAR PERIOD BASED UPON WYTHE COUNTY, VIRGINIA'S AUTOMATED SPEED ENFORCEMENT SYSTEM AGREEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(5) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE. (PIGGYBACK)

WHEREAS, the Police Department desires to implement a School Zone Safety Program that will utilize automated speed detection equipment pursuant to Section 316.008, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the School Zone Safety Program will include a public information and education campaign combined with an automated speed enforcement system that will improve traffic safety; and

WHEREAS, the automated school zone safety system was competitively bid by Wythe County, Virginia through Request for Proposals: Camera Speed Enforcement & Related Services on March 3, 2022, and awarded to Blue Line Solutions, LLC ("Blue Line") under an Automated Speed Enforcement System Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the current term of the Wythe County Automated Speed Enforcement System Agreement is from May 16, 2022 through May 15, 2026, with an option to automatically renew the contract for an additional two-year period; and

WHEREAS, Blue Line has agreed to extend to the City the same pricing under the terms and conditions set forth in the Automated Speed Enforcement System Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the period of performance during which the City's automated school zone safety system will be acquired is over a two-year period with the option to renew for additional two-year periods, so long as the underlying agreement utilizes the optional renewal terms; and

WHEREAS, there are no upfront equipment costs to the City for the School Zone Safety Program, and in the case of early termination, the City would have to pay for the remaining cost of the equipment, amortized over the two-year period; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes establishes the cost to the violator for the civil penalty at \$100, of which \$60 is allocated to the municipality for public safety use, and 25% of the fine will be retained by Blue Line for repayment of capital costs related to equipment and operating and maintenance of the program; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(5) of the Procurement Code allows the Interim Chief Procurement Officer to procure, without formal solicitation procedures, all goods, supplies, materials, equipment, and services that are the subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof ("piggyback"), provided that the goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services are the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the entities listed above and is based strictly on competitive bids, quotations, or competitive proposals and not on any preference and such utilization of other governmental entities contracts shall be permitted only during the term of the other governmental entity's contract; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Interim Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission authorize the execution of an agreement with Blue Line for an Automated Speed Enforcement Safety System, Services, and Related Equipment over a two-year period in an annual amount of \$0.00, with the option to renew for additional two-year periods.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of an agreement with Blue Line, together with such non-material changes as may subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
