Please explain your need for this equipment.

The City of Hollywood Police Department (HPD) serves a diverse community spanning approximately 30 square miles and is situated between the Cities of Ft. Lauderdale and Miami. The Department responds to approximately 196,000 calls for service annually. HPD employs over 330 sworn officers that respond to all law enforcement calls for service, and many medical calls aiding Fire Rescue. The HPD also holds a mutual aid agreement with all Broward County municipalities, offering our support to any of the 31 municipalities including those incorporated and unincorporated areas served by the Sheriff's Office. HPD Officers have been trained in the application of traumatic bleeding control techniques mirroring those skills taught to the United States Military. Each officer is issued one tourniquet, one chest seal, and one hemostatic bandage. The equipment used by our police department is sufficient for treating a single victim. This critical lifesaving equipment is imperative to operations but does not address mass casualty incidents. Mass casualty incidents include natural disasters (eg, hurricanes) and several types of intentional and unintentional man-made events, such as transportation disasters, explosions, and mass shootings. Due to an increase in crisis events nationwide, HPD has recognized the importance to provide its officers with the skills and equipment to treat multiple victims simultaneously. HPD would like to purchase the Chinook Medical LifePack Advanced equipment. The LifePack is a large red bag that contains 5 sealed kits, each equipped with a chest seal, hemostatic bandage, trauma dressing, C-A-T tourniquet, shears, and gloves. The acquisition of 40 of these kits will provide our front-line supervisors and officers with the ability to rapidly deploy life-saving equipment to our officers to treat multiple casualties. We appreciate your consideration in funding this project.
