He organized dozens of celebratory public events of United Nations during his career including the United Nations 60th Anniversary Celebration including development, supervision, monitoring and organizing the successful multi cultural and comprehensive world wide programmed dedicated to the 60th Anniversary of the Organization including special activities, events & projects such as the conference in San Francisco with the theme "Enhancing the Vital Role of the United Nations"; the UN Day programme during MIP TV (broadcasters) market at Cannes attended by 57 media executives representing all major broadcasters from around the world. He was the Executive Coordinator of the 7th United Nations Global Forum on Reinventing government. He organized and supervised various public awareness international events such art exhibitions, concerts and performances.
