SUBJECT: Proposed Blanket Purchase Order with Shrieve Chemical Company for the supply of sulfuric acid

I have discussed the above Agreement with the participating Department/Office, and the proposed general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

- 1) Department/Division involved – Public Utilities
 - 2) Type of Agreement – Blanket Purchase Order
 - 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) – Cooperative Purchase (Bid Number 2012-13/18) competitively bid by the City of Deerfield Beach. Section 38.46 of the City of Hollywood Code of Ordinances provides that the Director shall have the authority to join with other governmental entities in cooperative purchasing plans when the best interests of the city would be served thereby.
 - 4) Term of Contract
 - a) initial – 06/01/2013 through 05/31/2016
 - b) renewals (if any) – Three one-year terms (This is second renewal term).
 - c) who exercises option to renew – Mutual agreement of the parties
 - 5) Contract Amount – \$430,000.00
 - 6) Termination rights – City, acting through its City Manager or his/her designee, reserves the right to terminate the order in whole or in part for default (a) if Contractor fails to perform In accordance with any of the requirements of this order or (b) If Contractor becomes insolvent or suspends any of its operations or if any petition is filed or proceeding commenced by or against Contractor under any State or Federal Law relating to bankruptcy, reorganization, receivership or assignment for the benefit of creditors. Any such termination will be without liability to City except for completed items delivered and accepted by the City. Contractor, will be liable for excess costs of reprocurement.
 - 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements – Contractor shall comply with applicable City requirements.
 - 8) Scope of Services – Contractor shall supply the City with sulfuric acid at an adjusted base rate, adjusted quarterly, based upon the Green Market’s Tampa Price Sulfur Index.
 - 9) Other significant provisions – n/a
