Explanation:

The City hired Transmap Corporation to perform a Pavement Management Study which identified a number of alleys requiring reconstruction. The City desires to move forward with professional surveying and mapping services for twenty-nine (29) identified alleyway segments. Craven Thompson and Associates, subject to the City Commission's approval of the renewal of its professional services agreement, will provide professional surveying and mapping services for the alley resurfacing project.

On October 15, 2014, the City Commission adopted R-2014-301 which continued the appropriation for previously approved Capital Projects from FY 14 to FY 15 and included funding for the Alley Resurfacing Project. Funds are available in account #34.1400.14484.541.006303.

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
