The preference shall allow the local Hollywood vendor to submit a second and final offer, which must be at least 1% less than the bid of the lowest responsive responsible non-local Hollywood vendor to be awarded. The local Hollywood vendor shall have the burden of demonstrating that it maintains a permanent place of business with full-time employees within the City limits and has done so for a minimum of one (1) year prior to the date of issuance of a bid or proposal solicitation within Hollywood, Florida. All supporting documentation (e.g. City of Hollywood valid local business tax receipt) for local preference eligibility must be received with the bid package prior to the bid opening date and time.

Dual view Water Well Inspection Cameras provide a down-hole view and a detailed 360° continuous scan of sidewalls. A side view allows an operator to examine

wall, casings, infiltration, screen, gravel pack, encrustations, deterioration, perforation blockage or other physical damage.

X-Y Caliper with Gamma Ray (XYC/GR)



Openhole caliper comprised of 4 arms measuring the X and Y axis provides a continuous measurement of borehole diameter in inches. Defines hole size and shape which is especially important in deviated wells and elliptically shaped wellbores. The caliper data is used to estimate the total borehole volume and annular borehole volume for well-completion planning.

Gamma ray is used to measure natural gamma radioactivity in the rock formation. The radioactive elements which are measured include uranium, thorium, potassium, radium, and radon, along with the minerals that contain them. Gamma Ray logs are a useful tool used to interpret lithology. All Webb's Enterprises (AWE's) Gamma Ray tool is calibrated to American Petroleum Institute (A.P.I) standards.

Dual Induction Laterolog with Spontaneous Potential (DIL/LL3/SP)



By inducing an electromagnetic field (EMF) into the formations through the use of high voltage transmitter coils, the resulting eddy currents formed in the formations can be measured at the receiver coils and the conductivity / resistivity of the formation established. Coil spacing and arrangements are designed to maximize tool efficiency and to provide maximum depth of investigation.

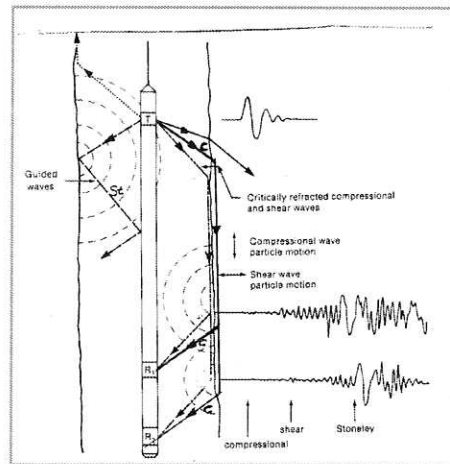
A primary property inherent to any formation is its ability to conduct or resist electricity. The measured values include RILD (deep induction), RILM (medium induction) and RLLS (shallow laterolog) these are converted to ohms to provide accurate resistivity/conductivity data.

Log responses will provide initial insight into formation potential, by the relationship of each of the three curves to each other.

This log is useful in analyzing water saturations and permeability.

Spontaneous Potential (SP) provides data on the salinity contrast between borehole and formation fluid, and the clay content of the permeable bed. The SP log is therefore useful in detecting permeable beds and to estimate formation water salinity and formation clay content.

Borehole Compensated Sonic with Variable Density Log (BHC/VDL)



(Crain's Petrophysical)

Provides acoustic measurements in both open and cased hole. Transmitters in the logging tool emit sound waves which are picked up and recorded by receivers. Measures formation transit time per cubic feet. Measurements are based on the first arrival travel time of the compressional wave. This log is used to determine the permeability and porosity of the well formation, assist in the interpretation and correlation of seismic records, and assist in determining lithology.

The variable density log is a graphical presentation of the BHC in which amplitude / wave form is presented in gray scale. It is displayed alongside the sonic log transit-time as a qualitative presentation of the acoustic wave train, and is sometimes used for fracture detection by examination of the chevron patterns. (Schlumberger).

Flowmeter



Flowmeter logs provide flow measurements downhole and are used to record velocity of fluid based on the speed of rotation of the tool impellor. Flowmeter readings are useful to identify flow zones.

Fluid Conductivity and Temperature



(Tool Example: Mountsopris)

This probe combination provides a continuous, depth-based measurement of fluid temperature and conductivity. The log is recorded downwards while running into the hole to minimize fluid disturbance.

Fluid temperature - Record the water temperature in the borehole. Temperature logs are useful for delineating water-bearing zones and identifying vertical flow in the borehole between zones of differing hydraulic head penetrated by wells. Borehole flow between zones is indicated by temperature gradients that are less than the regional geothermal gradient, which is about 1 degree Fahrenheit per 100 feet of depth.

Fluid conductivity - Record electric conductivity/resistivity of water/fluid in the borehole. Changes in fluid resistivity reflect differences in dissolved-solids concentration of water. Fluid conductivity logs are useful for delineating water-bearing zones and identifying vertical flow in boreholes. (Enviroporbe.com)
