- WHEREAS: THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY IS RECOGNIZED NATIONALLY AS BLACK HISTORY MONTH; AND
- WHEREAS: BLACK HISTORY MONTH HONORS AND AFFIRMS THE IMPORTANCE OF BLACK HISTORY THROUGHOUT OUR AMERICAN EXPERIENCE; AND
- WHEREAS: AFRICAN AMERICANS HAVE FACED OVERWHELMING ODDS IN MAKING THEIR NAMES AND STORIES KNOWN; AND
- WHEREAS: IN SPITE OF NUMEROUS BARRIERS, AFRICAN AMERICAN SCHOLARS, ARTISTS, ATHLETES AND LEADERS SELF-CONSCIOUSLY USED THEIR TALENTS TO CHANGE HOW THE WORLD VIEWED AFRICAN AMERICANS; AND
- WHEREAS: AT THE DAWN OF THESE STRIVINGS AND AT ALL POINTS ALONG THE ROAD, THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE STUDY OF AFRICAN AMERICAN LIFE AND HISTORY (ASALH) HAS PLAYED A VITAL ROLE; AND
- WHEREAS: IN 1915, DOCTOR CARTER G. WOODSON FOUNDED THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE STUDY OF AFRICAN AMERICAN LIFE AND HISTORY UNDER THE BELIEF THAT HISTORICAL TRUTH WOULD CRUSH FALSEHOODS AND USHER IN A NEW ERA OF EQUALITY, OPPORTUNITY AND RACIAL DEMOCRACY, WHICH HAS BEEN THE CHARGE OF THE ASSOCIATION FOR A CENTURY; AND
- WHEREAS: IN HONOR OF THIS MILESTONE, THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE STUDY OF AFRICAN AMERICAN LIFE AND HISTORY HAS SELECTED "A CENTURY OF BLACK LIFE, HISTORY, AND CULTURE" AS THE 2015 NATIONAL BLACK HISTORY THEME; AND
- WHEREAS: BLACK HISTORY MONTH IS A TIME FOR ALL AMERICANS TO REMEMBER AND REFLECT UPON THE BRAVERY, SELFLESS ACTS AND SACRIFICES OF AFRICAN AMERICANS WHO, THROUGHOUT AMERICAN HISTORY, HAVE SOUGHT FREEDOM FROM BONDAGE AND OPPRESSION, AND STROVE FOR EQUALITY, JUSTICE AND THE OPPORTUNITY TO SHARE FULLY IN THE AMERICAN EXPERIENCE; AND
