Re: City of Dania Beach's Request for Tolling Agreement

Dear George:

Thank you for your February 29, 2024, response to my February 27, 2024, letter regarding the City of Dania Beach's request for a refund of overcharges, referenced in that letter (the additional percentages charged and paid to Hollywood for debt service, which is the 10 and 15% surcharges, and the additional charges from the formula's application, and potential overcharges). The City of Dania Beach disagrees with the position and interpretation taken in your letter as to the application of the Large User Agreement. The City of Dania Beach believes that awaiting a decision by an appeals court is appropriate for a number of reasons.

The tolling agreement would continue to maintain the great working relationship that has developed between the City of Dania Beach and the City of Hollywood. It would also allow both cities to maintain their positions while the appeals court addresses the underlying issues in the City of Hollywood's dispute with the City of Pembroke Pines over the Large User. Because of the foregoing, the City of Dania Beach appreciates your offer to obtain the tolling agreement that the City of Dania Beach has requested from the City Commission of the City of Hollywood. We ask that you take whatever steps are necessary to obtain the authorization for the tolling agreement.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. Please advise when the tolling request will be presented to the City Commission.
