Eco Golf Club to Temporarily Close for Pump Station Improvements

Start Date: May 5, 2025

Estimated Completion Date: July 7, 2025

The City of Hollywood Department of Public Utilities is finalizing construction of a new pump station that will serve Deep Injection Wells 3 and 4 at the South Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant. This facility is located on the grounds of the Eco Golf Club, 1451 Taft Street.

Construction is scheduled to take place daily from approximately 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and will involve work in the northern portion of the golf course to install high-voltage infrastructure for Florida Power & Light to power the new pump station.

This project is part of the City's ongoing efforts to meet state-mandated requirements to eliminate ocean outfalls by 2025, as outlined in Florida law.

We sincerely appreciate your patience and understanding as we complete this critical infrastructure improvement.
