A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO MBF INDUSTRIES, INC. FOR MOBILE COMMAND VEHICLE UPFITTING IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$750,000.00 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(9) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE. (BEST INTEREST)

WHEREAS, the Police Department desires to update the interior workspace of its mobile command vehicle, which has reached the end of its useful lifespan, to support the efficient management of large-scale critical incidents; and

WHEREAS, MBF Industries, Inc. supplied and upfitted the existing mobile command vehicle in 2008, therefore, it possesses intricate knowledge of its design and build, as well as specialized materials to deconstruct and upfit the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to update the existing mobile command vehicle with MBF Industries, Inc., due to the increased costs and time required for purchasing and building a new vehicle, averaging \$1,000,000.00 and a delivery date of three years; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department obtained an estimated cost from the vendor of \$579,820.98, but anticipates additional expenditures arising during the project due to the age of the vehicle and has planned for \$170,000.00 of contingency to address additional costs and upgrades; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(9) of the Procurement Code states that when the City Commission declares by a five-sevenths (5/7ths) affirmative vote that competitive bidding and competitive proposals are not in the best interest of the City, such purchases are exempt from competitive bidding and competitive proposal requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the issuance of a Purchase Order to MBF Industries, Inc. for Mobile Command Vehicle Upfitting in an amount up to \$750,000.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project was included in the amended FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan, and is available in 335.209901.52100.564531.001609.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate City officials, of a purchase order to MBF Industries, Inc., together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
