Explanation:

This Resolution seeks the authority to make an additional payment to Tulio Fernando Bula and Monica Useche, "Claimants", in the amount of \$12,518.87 for damages caused to a home owned by Claimants resulting from a sewage backup into their home. Previously on December 17, 2014, the City Commission, pursuant to Resolution R-2014-370, authorized the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 in settlement of the damage claim filed against the City by Bula and Useche. The additional damages claimed by the Claimants cover the replacement cost of the home's damaged contents.

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Funding for the payment of the additional damage claim will be made available from the City's Self Insurance Fund 58 upon the approval by the City Commission of the payment of this additional claim amount.

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
