A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, NAMING THE WALKING
PATH AT STANLEY GOLDMAN MEMORIAL PARK AS THE
“CHRIS HIXON MEMORIAL TRAIL.”

WHEREAS, on December 4, 2024, the City Commission, by Resolution Number R-2024-397, implemented a new Naming Policy and Procedures (“Naming Policy”); and

WHEREAS, Chris Hixon was a Hollywood resident and 27-year Navy veteran who served in both Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hixon proudly served as Athletic Director at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, FL when he was tragically killed during the school shooting that took place on February 14, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2025, Commissioner Callari proposed naming the walking path at Stanley Goldman Memorial Park as the “Chris Hixon Memorial Trail”; and

WHEREAS, the request received City Commission support for the naming; and

WHEREAS, the Naming Policy provides that any proposed naming that is initiated by a City Commissioner shall be placed on a publicly noticed City Commission agenda for consideration without having to first be evaluated by the Naming Review Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission names the walking path at Stanley Goldman Memorial Park as the “Chris Hixon Memorial Trail.”

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
