A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE CITY'S UPDATED TRANSITION PLAN TO REMOVE ARCHITECTURAL BARRIERS IN CITY FACILITIES AS REQUIRED UNDER THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990.

WHEREAS, the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990 ("ADA") guarantees equal access to government programs and public facilities for persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to ensuring equal access in City facilities and services to further the intent of the ADA; and

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish this objective, the City performed an assessment of its facilities and adopted a transition plan on January 15, 1997 ("ADA Transition Plan"), pursuant to Resolution No. R-97-21, that removed architectural barriers and provided access to persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2021, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No R-2021-144 authorizing the issuance of an Authorization to Proceed with Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. to provide professional consulting engineering services to assist with an update of the ADA Transition Plan; and

WHEREAS, funding has been appropriated and exists in account number 117.149901.54100.531300.001498.000.000, and additional funding will be requested in subsequent fiscal years to further the progress with the ADA Transition Plan for the next five years to comply with the requirements of the ADA; and

WHEREAS, to implement the ADA Transition Plan and apply for various funding opportunities, City staff recommends that the City Commission adopt the attached ADA Transition Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the adoption of the attached ADA Transition Plan, as more specifically set forth in the attached Exhibit "A," together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

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Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
