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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPOINTING ONE MEMBER TO THE CIVIL SERVICE BOARD.

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Board primarily serves as an appellate review board relating to employee suspensions, demotions, terminations, testing, promotion, or placement challenges; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted the Civil Service Ordinance, No. O-84-14, which was subsequently approved by referendum on March 13, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. O-2010-30, removing the ordinance concerning Civil Service from the City Charter and placing it in the Code of Ordinances, and Ordinance No. O-2010-30 was subsequently approved by referendum on November 2, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the membership criteria for the vacant seats on the Civil Service Board are that the member must be a continuous resident of the City and must meet one of the following criteria of the vacating seats: a) an individual who is currently employed or who was previously employed by the private sector in the area of personnel administration; b) an individual employed or previously employed by the private sector, and not part of the management of his or her employer; c) an individual employed or previously employed by the private section and be part of the management of his or her employer; d) an individual self-employed or previously self-employed; e) an individual employed or previously employed by a public employer, but not currently employed by the City, or employed by Hollywood at any time during his or her service on the Board; and

WHEREAS, the term of Zulma Collazo, serving as an individual employed in the private sector in a personnel administration position, expires on June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the term of Dr. Jalane Meloun, serving as an individual employed in the private sector in a non-management position, expires on June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, there is currently a vacant position for an individual employed in the private sector in a management position due to the removal of Alex Recio, who was ineligible due to his dual office holding with the Charter Review Committee; and

WHEREAS, the term of Samuel Bentolila, serving as an individual self-employed or previously self-employed, expires on June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the term of Mitchell Anton, serving as an individual previously or presently employed in the public sector, expires on June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk provided notice to the public and solicited interest forms from citizens to fill current and upcoming vacancies; and

WHEREAS, the following candidates have expressed interest in membership and qualifies for appointment to the Civil Service Board as an individual employed in the private sector in a management position:
