

# IN RECOGNITION OF DRINKING WATER WEEK

**MAY 2-8, 2021**

- WHEREAS,** WATER IS OUR MOST VALUABLE NATURAL RESOURCE. WE ARE ALL STEWARDS OF THE WATER INFRASTRUCTURE UPON WHICH FUTURE GENERATIONS DEPEND; AND
- WHEREAS,** ONLY TAP WATER DELIVERS PUBLIC HEALTH PROTECTION, FIRE PROTECTION, SUPPORT FOR OUR ECONOMY AND THE QUALITY OF LIFE WE ENJOY; AND
