QUALITY COMMUNITY ADVOCACY AND LEGAL REPRESENTATION TO PROTECT EACH CHILD'S RIGHTS
AND BEST INTERESTS; AND

WHEREAS,
THE CURRENT BEST INTERESTS MODEL OF REPRESENTATION BY THE FLORIDA GUARDIAN AD LITEM OFFICE IS NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED AS A BEST PRACTICE BECAUSE IT USES A MULTI-DISCIPLINARY TEAM MODEL THAT INCLUDES AN ATTORNEY, A CERTIFIED CHILD ADVOCATE MANAGER, AND A TRAINED VOLUNTEER OR PRO BONO ATTORNEY; AND

WHEREAS,
FOR MORE THAN 40 YEARS, THE FLORIDA GUARDIAN AD LITEM OFFICE HAS PROVIDED ASSISTANCE
TO THE MOST VULNERABLE CHILDREN IN FLORIDA WITH AN ADULT FROM THEIR COMMUNITY WHO IS
A CONSISTENT, POSITIVE PRESENCE IN THE CHILD'S LIFE; AND

WHEREAS,
FOR MORE THAN 30 YEARS, THE FLORIDA GUARDIAN AD LITEM OFFICE HAS PROVIDED INDEPENDENT LEGAL ADVOCACY FOR HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF VULNERABLE CHILDREN THROUGHOUT FLORIDA. IN 2021, THE FLORIDA GUARDIAN AD LITEM OFFICE HAD MORE THAN 13,000 VOLUNTEERS ADVOCATING FOR MORE THAN 37,000 CHILDREN IN FLORIDA; AND

WHEREAS,
THE GUARDIAN AD LITEM PROGRAM IN THE 17TH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT IN BROWARD COUNTY OVERSES
A VOLUNTEER BASE OF OVER 520 PEOPLE; AND THOSE VOLUNTEERS ADVOCATE FOR MORE THAN
1,500 CHILDREN IN BROWARD COUNTY; AND

WHEREAS,
GUARDIAN AD LITEM PRO BONO ATTORNEYS AND VOLUNTEERS SACRIFICE THEIR TIME AND
MILEAGE; A SAVINGS WORTH MILLIONS OF DOLLARS ANNUALLY TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA,
AND PROVIDE AN INVALUABLE SERVICE TO DEPENDENCY COURT JUDGES; AND

WHEREAS,
STUDIES SHOW THAT CHILDREN WITH A GUARDIAN AD LITEM ARE MORE LIKELY TO BE ADOPTED,
HALF AS LIKELY TO RE-ENTER FOSTER CARE, LESS LIKELY TO SPEND TIME IN LONG-TERM FOSTER
CARE, MORE LIKELY TO HAVE A PERMANENCY PLAN, AND MORE LIKELY TO PERFORM WELL IN
SCHOOL; NOW
