A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FLORIDA. APPROVING HOLLYWOOD, AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO RENEW UNIT PRICE CONTRACT THE WITH **ENVIROWASTE** SERVICES GROUP. INC. **FOR** SERVICES CONSTRUCTION RELATED TO THE REDUCTION OF INFLOW AND INFILTRATION - MANHOLE REPAIRS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,057,085.00.

WHEREAS, the City is responsible for continually assessing and ensuring the functionality of the wastewater collection system, including 85 lift stations and over 280 miles of sewer mains; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") has a long-standing program to reduce the inflow and infiltration ("I/I") of storm and groundwater to the wastewater collection system, which program includes the repair and replacement of manholes and other wastewater collection system components; and

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2023, pursuant to Resolution No. R-2023-123, the City Commission authorized the execution of a unit price contract with Envirowaste Services Group, Inc. ("Envirowaste") in the amount of \$1,057,085.00 for I/I Program – Manhole Repairs; and

WHEREAS, the existing contract with Envirowaste is for an initial term of one year, with two optional one-year renewal terms; and

WHEREAS, the Department Director and the Interim Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the appropriate City officials to execute a renewal contract with Envirowaste for construction services related to I/I Program - Manhole Repairs; and

WHEREAS, funding for the project was included in the amended FY 2024 Capital Improvement Plan, and is available in account number 442.409901.53600.563010.000712.000.000; and

WHEREAS, the contract is renewed for an additional 365 days from the expiration date of the original agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of a contract with Envirowaste, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.
