Chapter 52 of the Code of Ordinances, titled "SEWER USE," regulates the sanitary sewer system owned and operated by the City of Hollywood, Florida, including the fees and charges paid by its customers.

The Department of Public Utilities has reviewed the subchapter of Chapter 52 titled "Fees and Charges" and recommends amendments to sections regarding tapping charges, connection deposits and rates and charges for use of the sanitary sewer system.

The ordinance will be amended to allow the rates for tapping charges and connection deposits to be set via resolution; and changes the requirements and allowances for sewer credits.
