

IN RECOGNITION OF JEWISH AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH

- WHEREAS,** THIS MAY, JEWISH AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH – ESTABLISHED BY PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION EACH YEAR SINCE 2006 – WILL RECOGNIZE THE INDELIBLE CONTRIBUTIONS JEWISH AMERICANS HAVE MADE, AND CONTINUE TO MAKE, TO OUR NATION'S HISTORY, CULTURE, AND SOCIETY; AND
- WHEREAS,** FOR MORE THAN 360 YEARS, JEWISH AMERICANS SUCH AS ALBERT EINSTEIN AND RUTH BADER GINSBURG, HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO AMERICAN CULTURE AND SOCIETY. FROM SPORTS, HISTORY, ART, MUSIC AND ENTERTAINMENT TO MEDICINE, BUSINESS, SCIENCE, GOVERNMENT, AND MILITARY SERVICE. ACROSS THESE FIELDS, MANY JEWISH AMERICANS HAVE CONTRIBUTED SIGNIFICANTLY TO THIS NATION'S STRUGGLE FOR FREEDOM, JUSTICE AND LIBERTY, BRINGING PROGRESS IN ALL ASPECTS OF THIS NATION'S VALUES AND CHARACTER; AND
- WHEREAS,** MANY JEWISH WOMEN AND MEN MADE LIFE-LONG COMMITMENTS TO CONFRONT THE ENEMY OF AMERICA'S NOBLEST GOALS: RACISM AND OPPRESSION. THEY FOUND SOLIDARITY IN THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT, THE FIGHT FOR WOMEN'S AND LGBT RIGHTS, AND STRUGGLES WHICH OFTEN MIRRORED THE STORY OF EXODUS AND THE JEWISH PEOPLE'S JOURNEY THROUGH THE AGES. MANY JEWISH PEOPLE FOUND AMERICA'S BEST VALUES IN EACH OF THESE CAUSES: A DEMAND FOR FAIRNESS, EQUALITY AND JUSTICE; AND
- WHEREAS,** THE RISE IN ANTI-SEMITISM DEMANDS THAT ALL AMERICANS KNOW THE LESSONS OF THE HOLOCAUST. WE MUST RECOGNIZE THAT THERE IS AN URGENCY TO CONTINUALLY COMBAT PREJUDICE BEFORE IT FIRMLY TAKES ROOT. THE RE-EMERGENCE OF VIOLENT ANTI-SEMITISM AIMED AT PLACES OF WORSHIP REQUIRES THAT WE RECOMMIT, THROUGH ACTION AND SOLIDARITY, THAT AN ATTACK ON THE FAITH OF ONE IS AN ATTACK ON THE FAITH OF ALL; AND
- WHEREAS,** THIS JEWISH AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH TAKES ITS THEME FROM THE ANCIENT SAGE, RABBI HILLEL'S MOST WELL-KNOWN SAYING—"IF I AM ONLY FOR MYSELF, WHAT AM I? IF NOT NOW—WHEN?"—AND THE WORK OF RABBI ABRAHAM JOSHUA HESCHEL, WHO MARCHED WITH DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. IN SELMA; AND
- WHEREAS,** JEWISH AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH WILL HIGHLIGHT HISTORICAL MOMENTS IN WHICH THE AMERICAN COMMUNITIES DEMONSTRATED REMARKABLE RESILIENCE AND CARE FOR COMMUNITIES OUTSIDE THEIR OWN, AND ALSO HOW DIVERSE COMMUNITIES STOOD UP FOR JEWISH AMERICANS IN THE FACE OF ANTISEMITISM; NOW
- THEREFORE,** JOSH LEVY, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AND THE HOLLYWOOD CITY COMMISSION, HEREBY PROCLAIM MAY 2022 TO BE RECOGNIZED AS:
