

IN RECOGNITION OF NATIONAL TAKE OUR DAUGHTERS AND SONS TO WORK DAY

APRIL 10, 2015

- WHEREAS: IN 1993, THE FOUNDATION FOR WOMEN ESTABLISHED "TAKE OUR DAUGHTERS TO WORK DAY"; AND
- WHEREAS: THIS ANNUAL PROGRAM NOW ALSO INCLUDES SONS AND IS TRADITIONALLY HELD ON THE FOURTH THURSDAY IN APRIL; AND
- WHEREAS: *TAKE OUR DAUGHTERS AND SONS TO WORK DAY* IS A NATIONAL, PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAM, CONNECTING WHAT CHILDREN LEARN AT SCHOOL WITH THE WORKING WORLD; AND
- WHEREAS: THE THEME FOR THE 2015 CELEBRATION IS “#MPOWR: KNOWLEDGE + CHOICE = STRENGTH” AND WILL PROVIDE A FORUM TO HELP TEACH KIDS ABOUT THE WORK DAY WORLD OF THEIR PARENTS AND TO GET THEM DREAMING ABOUT THEIR OWN CAREERS; AND
- WHEREAS: *TAKE OUR DAUGHTERS AND SONS TO WORK DAY* ALLOWS ADULTS THE OPPORTUNITY TO SHOW HOW SCHOOL WORK RELATES TO REAL WORK; GIVES GIRLS AND BOYS A UNIQUE EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY THAT EXPANDS THE WALLS OF THE CLASSROOM AND HELPS THEM REACH THEIR FULL POTENTIAL; AND
- WHEREAS: FOR MANY YEARS, THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD HAS WELCOMED ELIGIBLE CHILDREN TO THE WORKPLACE FOR THIS SPECIAL EVENT, CONTRIBUTING TO ACTIVITIES HELD ON THIS DAY BY PROVIDING A VENUE FOR YOUTH TO VOICE THEIR QUESTIONS AND INTERESTS ABOUT CAREER CHOICES; AND
