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I AM A DETECTIVE ASSIGNED TO THE HOLLYWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT STREET CRIMES UNIT. I HAVE KNOWLEDGE, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCE DEALING WITH STREET LEVEL NARCOTICS ACTIVITY.

ON 01/02/2014 I WAS CONDUCTING SURVEILLANCE AT 2602 NORTH 22ND AVENUE "POPS B.B.Q.". NOTE: THE STATED LOCATION IS THE SOURCE OF ONGOING COMPLAINTS REGARDING THE SALE AND USE OF NARCOTICS.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1649 HOURS I OBSERVED A BLACK MALE IDENTIFIED AS THE DEFENDANT, TAVARES ANDERSON SMOKING A CANNABIS CIGAR AT THE STATED LOCATION. I ATTEMPTED TO INITIATE A SUBJECT STOP. THE DEFENDANT DID DISCARD THE CANNABIS CIGAR WHEN HE OBSERVED POLICE. I RECOVERED THE STATED NARCOTIC AND PLACED THE DEFENDANT INTO CUSTODY.

A FIELD TEST RETURNED POSITIVE RESULTS FOR THE PRESENCE OF CANNABIS.

ON JANUARY 18, 2014 AT APPROXIMATELY 5:10 AM, I RESPONDED TO 2602 N 22 AVENUE (POPS OLD TIME BBQ) REFERENCE A MALE RAN OVER BY A VEHICLE. UPON ARRIVAL, I SAW A BLACK MALE LATER IDENTIFIED AS JEFFREY WELCOME LYING ON THE PAVEMENT OF THE PARKING LOT OF POPS BBQ. WELCOME COMPLAINED OF PAIN TO HIS RIGHT LEG AND THOUGHT IT WAS BROKEN.

JUST PRIOR TO MY ARRIVAL ON SCENE, SGT GERBER STOPPED A WHITE NISSAN 4 DR (FL#855VFC) ON THE 2300 BLOCK OF SHERIDAN STREET. HE DETAINED THE DRIVER WHO WAS IDENTIFIED AS TAWANDA TRICALE FRAZIER BROWN PENDING FURTHER INVESTIGATION. WHILE ON SCENE WELCOME WAS UNCOOPERATIVE AND DID NOT PROVIDE MUCH INFORMATION OTHER THAN HE WAS HIT BY A CAR. NO OTHER PERSON ON SCENE CLAIMED TO BE A WITNESS TO THE INCIDENT. I RESPONDED TO MEMORIAL REGIONAL HOSPITAL WHERE WELCOME WAS TRANSPORTED AND ATTEMPTED TO INTERVIEW HIM AGAIN, BUT WELCOME STATED HE WOULD NOT BE PROVIDING ME ANY INFORMATION AND DID NOT WISH TO PRESS CHARGES.

I THEN RESPONDED TO THE 2300 BLOCK OF SHERIDAN STREET AND SPOKE WITH BROWN WHO STATED THAT SHE AND WELCOME ARE ON AND OFF AGAIN BOYFRIEND/GIRLFRIEND. THEY WERE INVOLVED IN AN ARGUMENT IN OPA LOCKA APPROXIMATELY 2 HOURS PRIOR TO THIS INCIDENT. WELCOME LEFT AND BROWN FOLLOWED HIM TO A GAS STATION OFF MIRAMAR PARKWAY AND UNIVERSITY DR. BROWN STATED THAT ANOTHER DISTURBANCE BROKE OUT THERE BEFORE THEY SEPERATED. WELCOME LATER CALLED HER AND ASKED HER TO COME BY POPS BBQ. WHEN SHE ARRIVED ANOTHER ARGUMENT ENSUED DUE TO TWO OTHER FEMALES THAT WELCOME WAS WITH. BROWN ADMITS TAKING A KNIFE AND SLASHING ALL 4 OF THE TIRES TO WELCOME'S VEHICLE AND THEN SHE STATED THAT SHE FEARED HE WOULD STILL DRIVE OFF AND WENT TO BOX IN HIS VEHICLE FROM THE REAR WITH HER VEHICLE. SHE STATES SHE DID NOT KNOW SHE HIT HIM AND IT WAS NEVER HER INTENTION.

WELCOME AND BROWN BOTH REFUSED CRIME SCENE. CASE CARDS AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE BROCHURES ISSUED.

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ON THE ABOVE DATE AT THE ABOVE TIME I RESPONDED TO THE ABOVE LOCATION IN REFERENCE TO A BATTERY THAT OCCURRED INSIDE OF 2602 N 22ND AV ON JANUARY 18, 2014 AT APPROXIMATELY 1200 HOURS. UPON MY ARRIVAL I MADE CONTACT WITH ANTRON MCCRAY.

MCCRAY STATED THAT ON JANUARY 18, 2014 HE WAS IN A VERBAL DISPUTE WITH THE COOK INSIDE OF 2602 N 22ND AV. MCCRAY ADVISED THAT HE TURNED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES AND GOT ATTACKED FROM BEHIND. MCCRAY INDICATED THAT HIS ATTACKER THREW HIS FACE INTO THE WALL AND BEAT THE BACK OF HIS HEAD. MCCRAY BELIEVED HIS ATTACKER WAS THE COOK; A MAN HE LATER FOUND OUT GOES BY THE NAME RANZEL DAVIS.

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ON 03/12/14, AT APPROXIMATELY 2020 HOURS, I MET WITH THE VICTIM, KENNETH M. SYLVESTER, IN THE HOLLYWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT LOBBY IN REFERENCE TO A LATE VEHICLE THEFT REPORT.

THE VICTIM STATED ON 03/07/14, AT APPROXIMATELY 2130 HOURS, WHILE "HANGING OUT" AT THE LOCATION OF 2602 N 22 AVE (POP'S OLD TIME BBQ), HE MET THE SUSPECT KNOWN TO HIM AS "BLACK". "BLACK" ASKED THE VICTIM TO USE HIS VEHICLE FOR SOME "STUFF HE HAD TO DO WITH HIS FAMILY AND ERRANDS" IN WHICH THE VICTIM PROVIDED THE SUSPECT WITH THE VEHICLE KEY AS THE SUSPECT STATED HE WOULD RETURN THE VEHICLE TO HIM ON 03/08/14, AT 0800 HOURS. 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ON 03/30/2014 AT APPROXIMATELY 2338 HRS I RESPONDED TO POP'S BBQ (2602 N 22ND AV) IN REFERENCE TO A DISTURBANCE. UPON MY ARRIVAL, I MADE CONTACT WITH THE REPORTEE CLARENCE JONES, WHO ADVISED THAT A B/M SUBJECT BEGAN CAUSING A DISTURBANCE WHILE BRANDISHING A FIREARM.

WHILE ON SCENE, THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT HE WAS PLAYING BILLIARDS INSIDE THE CLUB, WHEN A B/M SUBJECT APPROACHED HIM. THE REPORTEE ADVISED THAT THE B/M SUBJECT BEGAN TALKING TO HIM AND PULLED OUT A FIREARM FROM HIS WAISTBAND AND PUT IT ON THE POOL TABLE. UPON MY ARRIVAL, CONTACT WAS MADE WITH BARRINGTON LABEACH. LABEACH WAS OBSERVED TO BE SHIRT LESS AND HAD AN ABRASION ON HIS LEFT ELBOW. STATED HE WAS BATTERED BY AN ACQUAINTANCE, LATER IDENTIFIED AS RICHARD SINGLETARY.
