Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization to issue a Blanket Purchase Order for lot clearing and tractor mowing on non-maintained, improved properties and vacant lots.

On May 7, 2014, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution Number R-2014-106, which authorized the services of lot clearing and tractor mowing on non-maintained, improved properties and vacant lots for a one (1) year period with the right to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods.

The Chief of Police and Director of Procurement Services recommend that the City Commission issue a blanket purchase order under the same terms, conditions, and pricing for the first of the two (2) renewal periods, from May 21, 2015 through May 20,

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2016 based on the satisfactory performance provided by Weed-A-Way over the past year, and subject to the City's receipt of all required insurance, approval by the City's Risk Manager and other terms and conditions required by the City Manager and City Attorney.
