A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE HIGHEST-RANKED FIRM, R.J. BEHAR & COMPANY, INC., FOR CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING INSPECTION SERVICES DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE HOLLYWOOD TIDAL FLOODING MITIGATION AND SHORELINE PROTECTION SITES 9,10,17,19,2,22,1 & 18 (FDEP 22FRP13), A GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND PROJECT, IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$399,062.91.

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2019, the City held a Special Election whereby a majority of voters approved funding in the amount of \$14,091,065.00, through a General Obligation Bond ("GO Bond"), for the Tidal Flooding Mitigation and Shoreline Protection Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, on September 21, 2022, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2022-281, approving the appropriate City officials to accept and execute FDEP Resilient Florida Grant ("Agreement No. 22FRP13") and authorizing the required matching funds to be paid from the GO Bond; and

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2023, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2023-402, approving and authorizing the appropriate City officials to execute Amendment No. 1 to the FDEP Resilient Florida Grant, renaming the Project Hollywood Tidal Flooding and Mitigation and Shoreline Protection, and approving and authorizing the appropriate City officials to execute all applicable grant documents, agreements and amendments; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2025, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2025-288, approving and authorizing the appropriate City Officials to execute a Construction Management at Risk Phase II Construction Services Agreement with the Whiting-Turner Contracting Company for construction of Hollywood Tidal Flooding Mitigation and Shoreline Protection Project Sites 9,10,17,19,2,22,1 and 18 FDEP 22FRP13 ("RFP-274-25-WV"), in an amount up to \$20,762,347.00; and

WHEREAS, Agreement No. 22FRP13 requires that the recipients of federal funds demonstrate compliance with federal requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Design and Construction Management ("DCM") desires to hire an engineering consultant to provide construction engineering inspections and federal contract compliance specialist services for this Project; and

WHEREAS, on October 9, 2025, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No, R-2025-342, ranking construction engineering inspection services firms and authorizing the appropriate City officials to negotiate an agreement with the top ranked firm to provide construction engineering inspections and federal contract compliance specialist services for this Project; and

WHEREAS, DCM negotiated the Project scope and fee with R.J. Behar and Company, Inc., in an amount up to \$399,062.91, that staff has determined to be fair and reasonable and in accordance with industry standards; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Director of DCM recommends that the City Commission approve and authorize the appropriate City officials to execute a contract for construction engineering inspection services with R.J. Behar and Company, Inc., in an amount up to \$399,062.91; and

WHEREAS, funding for this Project was included in the amended FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan and is available in account numbers 333.149901.54100.563010.001187.000.000, 111.179901.51900.563010.001678.000.000, 337.179901.54100.563010.001187.000.000 and 334.179901.51900.531213.001360.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute a contract with the highest-ranked firm, R.J. Behar and Company, Inc. to provide construction engineering inspection services during the construction of the Hollywood Tidal Flooding Mitigation and Shoreline Protection Project Sites 9,10,17,19, 2, 22, 1, 18 (FDEP 22FRP13), in an amount up to \$399,062.91, together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
