Scope:

- Isolate all energy sources and lock-out tag-out
- Set up any necessary rigging to safely perform the proposed work
- Disconnect, remove, and disposed of existing air handlers and condenser for A/C systems 2, 4 and 5
- Flush existing refrigerant lines with Rx11-flush so they can be reused with with new refrigerant
- Receive and prepare new system for installation at our warehouse and deliver to jobsite
- Install new split systems using existing ducts as well as existing electrical and refrigerant lines
- Supply and install new auxiliary overflow safety switches
- Deliver and set new condensing units onto existing concrete pads
- Set new AHUs onto existing stands
- Insulate any new refrigerant piping with 3/4" wall Armaflex
- All brazing will be done under nitrogen purge
- Cap existing refrigerant lines and pressurize with dry nitrogen to 350 psi to check for leaks
- Dehydrate refrigerant circuits to < 500 microns and charge with new refrigerant
- Start up to ensure proper operation of new systems
- Clean work area and check out with customer's approval

Exclusions / Clarifications:

This proposal includes wind-load, and mechanical permits processing and acquisition but not permit fees by the bldg. dept. Permit fees will be passed through at cost x1.35 or can be paid directly by the city. Fire alarm/smoke detector addition/integration or any other system controls integration is not included. Not included in this proposal is any code upgrades, painting, drywall patching, temporary cooling or fireproofing. Also not included in this proposal is any labor outside our normal business hours. In addition, any alterations or deviation from the above specifications involving extra cost, will be executed only upon written orders, and will become an extra charge over and above this proposal's price. If any leaks are found in the existing refrigerant lines, a separate proposal will be presented to address the required repairs. Customer's fire life safety vendor will need to be present for final inspection.
