

IN RECOGNITION OF PUBLIC SERVICE RECOGNITION WEEK

- WHEREAS: PUBLIC SERVICE IS AMONG THE MOST NOBLE AND DEMANDING OF PROFESSIONS; AND
- WHEREAS: THIS YEAR’S THEME, “CELEBRATING 90 YEARS OF SERVICE”, GIVES CITIZENS THE CHANCE TO SEE THE BREADTH OF GROUNDBREAKING WORK BEING DONE IN GOVERNMENT, AND TO EXPLORE THE MANY WAYS TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE BY CHOOSING CAREERS IN PUBLIC SERVICE; AND
- WHEREAS: EXCELLENCE IN THE DELIVERY OF PUBLIC SERVICE HELPS TO KEEP HOLLYWOOD STRONG AND PROSPEROUS AS WELL AS A WONDERFUL PLACE IN WHICH TO LIVE, WORK AND PLAY; AND
- WHEREAS: PUBLIC EMPLOYEES AND VOLUNTEERS, THROUGH THEIR COMMITMENT TO EXCELLENCE AND DIVERSITY OF SKILLS, HAVE MADE GREAT CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD IN AREAS SUCH AS PUBLIC SAFETY, RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES, NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION, AND THE DELIVERY OF WATER AND SEWER; AND
- WHEREAS: THE EFFECTIVENESS AND EFFICIENCY OF GOVERNMENT DEPEND, IN LARGE MEASURE, ON PUBLIC EMPLOYEES WHOSE TASK IT IS TO PROVIDE, ON A DAILY BASIS, A BROAD RANGE OF SERVICES OF THE QUALITY REQUIRED AND EXPECTED BY THE PUBLIC; AND
- WHEREAS: THE IMPORTANCE OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE RENDERED BY PUBLIC EMPLOYEES, AND THE EXEMPLARY MANNER OF THEIR PERFORMANCE, ARE OFTEN FORGOTTEN OR OVERLOOKED; AND
- WHEREAS: TO PROVIDE EVEN BETTER SERVICE TO THE PUBLIC, THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD HAS COMMITTED TO AN ORGANIZATIONAL CULTURE OF CUSTOMER SERVICE EXCELLENCE AND EMPLOYEE INVOLVEMENT; AND
- WHEREAS: THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD RECOGNIZES THE CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY PUBLIC EMPLOYEES AS WELL AS VOLUNTEERS AT ALL LEVELS OF CITY GOVERNMENT, AND FINDS IT FITTING TO SET ASIDE A SPECIAL TIME TO HONOR AND THANK THESE DEDICATED INDIVIDUALS WHO PERFORM SUCH VITAL ROLES; AND
