  - a) initial commences on June 1, 2018 and expires on June 15, 2019.

- 5) Contract Amount In an amount not to exceed \$20,563.00.
- 6) Termination rights Yes, with or without cause. (See Article 9).

- 8) Scope of Services- Hispanic Unity of Florida, Inc. will provide first-time homebuyer counseling, foreclosure prevention counseling, financial coaching, financial management education, and/or extended financial management to Hollywood residents.
