Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to execute a Recreational License Agreement with School Board of Broward County (SBBC).

The City of Hollywood and the School Board of Broward County desire to enter into a Recreation License Agreement for the purposes of allowing the City to utilize portions of land, a/k/a Hollywood Hills Elementary School, owned by the School Board of Broward County for recreational purposes. Security fencing with a gate currently exists there that was installed by the City, separating the school campus from the Licensed Premises. Key Access code is provided for both SBBC and the City.

The term of this Agreement shall commence on December 18, 2018 and conclude on December 17, 2043.

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
