A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED LAW ENFORCEMENT MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD AND SCOTT J. ISRAEL, AS SHERIFF OF BROWARD COUNTY FOR TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT.

WHEREAS, Section 23.1225(1) and (2), Florida Statutes, allows governmental entities to enter into mutual aid agreements for certain purposes including traffic enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement (Mutual Aid Agreement) expressly provides for traffic enforcement activities relating to civil traffic offenses across jurisdictional boundaries in certain defined circumstances within Broward County for the purpose of protecting the public peace and safety and preserving the lives and property of the citizens of each respective governmental entity; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Mutual Aid Agreement is separate and apart from the current Countywide Mutual Aid Agreement for Voluntary Cooperation and Operational Assistance which provides for extra-jurisdictional authority for criminal offenses, including criminal traffic infractions which expires in 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police for the City of Hollywood recommends that the City Commission authorize the appropriate City Officials to execute a Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement between the City of Hollywood and Broward Sheriff for extra-jurisdictional authority for traffic enforcement relating to civil traffic offenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby approves and authorizes the appropriate City Officials to execute the attached Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement for Traffic Enforcement between the City of Hollywood and Scott J. Israel, as Sheriff of Broward County, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
