I. SURVEYING SERVICES

1.1 Prepare Topographic Survey (CT&A Task No. 11050)

Prepare topographic surveys for engineering design purposes for twenty-eight (28) individual site's, encompassing a total of 14,675 linear feet for alley reconstruction. The project limits are listed in the attached **"EXHIBIT A"**. The surveys will consist of crosssections at fifty (50) foot intervals, along the route with elevations within the rights-of-way of the alleys, at each edge of pavement, and center of alley, including five (5) feet outside of the rights-of-way, where it is accessible and safe for the survey crew members to enter private property.

Locations will include above-ground, visible improvements, including pavement, curbing, signs, street lights, driveways and utility features within the rights-of-way.

Elevations will be based on North American Vertical Datum of 1988 (NAVD 88) and referenced to National Geodetic Survey (NGS), or Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) benchmarks.

All survey data will meet the current standards for surveying in Florida, as defined under Chapter 5J-17.050-.052, F.A.C.

Lump Sum:......\$55,620.00

Deliverables will include an electronic AutoCAD Civil 3D file, version 2014, for each site, with signed and sealed hard copies provided at the conclusion of the project.

Estimated time of completion: Based on receiving the Notice to Proceed after January 1, 2015, the first electronic file will be delivered within three (3) weeks, with three (3) sites per week delivered thereafter. Twelve (12) weeks total, weather permitting.

In addition, all research and calculation time required in the preparation of this affidavit, report or certificate will be charged at our normal hourly rates for the individuals preparing the affidavit.
