A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ISSUE THE ATTACHED BLANKET PURCHASE ORDER BETWEEN POLYDYNE INC. AND THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF LIQUID POLYMER IN AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$145,000.00

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Utilities requires the Supply and Delivery of Liquid Polymer used in the sludge dewatering process at the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the required Supply and Delivery of Liquid Polymer was competitively bid by the City of Ormond Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ormond Beach, Florida's Bid Number 2014-25 was opened on July 23, 2014 and was awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Polydyne Inc. on September 15, 2014 for a one (1) year agreement with the option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods; and

WHEREAS, Polydyne Inc. is currently providing these services to the City in a satisfactory manner; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Utilities and the Director of Procurement Services recommend that the City Commission approve the issuance of the attached Blanket Purchase Order for the Supply and Delivery of Liquid Polymer to Polydyne Inc. in an estimated annual amount of \$145,000.00; and

WHEREAS, award is subject to the City's receipt and approval of all insurance certificates required by the City's Risk Manager; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That it hereby approves and authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate City Officials, of the attached Blanket Purchase Order between Polydyne Inc. and the City of Hollywood, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 2:</u> That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
