On June 6, 2022, our department experienced the loss of DE Christopher Allen. After his passing there was a group of members who stepped up to help honor him and his family. From the beginning, DE Brandon Pellecer has been a liaison between the Department and the Allen family. He has been a pillar of support for the family from the funeral to the multiple memorials that DE Allen’s name has been added to. On November 18, 2022, DE Pellecer was with the Allen family in Ocala when his name was added to the Florida Fallen Firefighter Memorial. On September 16, 2023, DE Pellecer once again escorted the family to Colorado Springs during the Annual IAFF’s Fall Fighters Memorial Service, where DE Allen’s name was etched onto the memorial’s wall. DE Pellecer has gone above and beyond the call of duty to honor our fallen brother and has been a shoulder for the family to lean on in their time of grief.

Along with DE Pellecer, there is another group who has stood by to make sure DE Allen received the proper honor for his service to the City of Hollywood. The department’s Honor Guard Team has shown what it means to be a part of the Fire Service and to honor a fallen brother. They dutifully stood by his casket at the funeral, never leaving his side during the ceremony. At the memorial services in Ocala and Colorado Springs, the team stood by with flags, axes, and pike poles, spending hours at attention. They embody all the fundamentals and values of the Hollywood Fire Department. For these reasons, we would like to recognize these members for the Meritorious Service Award.
