A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A BLANKET PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH NALCO WATER, INC. FOR THE DELIVERY AND SUPPLY OF NALCO PC-1850T ANTISCALANT AND 3D TRASAR TECHNOLOGY FOR AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$195,000.00 OVER A THREE YEAR PERIOD FROM MARCH 11, 2023 THROUGH MARCH 10, 2026, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(2) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE (SOLE SOURCE).

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") desires to purchase Nalco PC-1850T Antiscalant and 3D Trasar Technology for use on the reverse osmosis and nano filtration water treatment membranes to prevent scale formation and the fouling of the membrane surfaces; and

WHEREAS, the antiscalant is a pretreatment water additive used in reverse osmosis and nano filtration systems that is highly effective in preventing the membranes from scaling and resultant filtration failure; and

WHEREAS, Nalco Water, Inc. ("Nalco") is the sole manufacturer and distributor of Nalco PC-1850T Antiscalant used in the RO 3D TRASAR patented process, which provides both chemical and component monitoring of real-time chemical addition; and

WHEREAS, the Department and the Chief Procurement Officer have determined that Nalco PC-1850T Antiscalant and 3D Trasar Technology from Nalco is a sole source purchase, as documented by the sole source letter provided by Nalco and a sole source posting on Opengov; and

WHEREAS, Notice to Sole Source Number NTSS-040-23 was posted electronically on Opengov from December 20, 2022 through December 29, 2022, and received no inquiries; and

WHEREAS, the delivery and supply of Nalco PC-1850T Antiscalant and 3D Trasar Technology will be for a three year period from March 11, 2023 through March 10, 2026, for an annual amount of \$195,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Utilities and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the execution of a Blanket Purchase Agreement with Nalco for the delivery and supply of Nalco PC-1850T Antiscalant and 3D Trasar Technology for an annual amount of \$195,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(2) of the City's Procurement Code exempts solesource goods, supplies, materials, equipment and services, such as unique, patented, or franchised goods, supplies, materials, equipment or services, from the competitive bid requirements if the Chief Procurement Officer determines after conducting a good faith review of available sources, that the particular supply or service is available from one source; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Blanket Purchase Agreement is available in account number 441.400501.53600.552330.000000.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of a Blanket Purchase Agreement with Nalco Water, Inc., together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
