





4) TAB E: APPROACH TO THE SCOPE OF WORK

A) SCHEDULING

Persons Services Corp. understands the critical nature of setting accurate scheduling milestones in any construction program to ensure all project timelines are organized in the most efficient manner. Persons Services Corp. is familiar with the permitting processes in the local area and will work closely with the municipality providing proper documents expeditiously, thoroughly, and professionally. Simultaneously, PSC will execute a competitive bidding process to ensure best-value subcontractors become part of the construction team. As part of this process, PSC will require a Critical Path Method of construction of all subcontractors to ensure timely completion of work. PSC understands that proper scheduling reduces costs for both the customer and the contractors. When all stakeholders work collaboratively, the project is executed successfully.

B) BENCHMARKING PROCESSES

Persons Services Corp. understands that benchmarking is the cornerstone to creating successful construction processes. The importance of tracking data and milestones is one of the reasons PSC was inspired to create our custom project management software, ProjectVista. Persons Services Corp. will use ProjectVista to track our benchmarking decisions throughout the program. PSC will work with the City and the Architect and Engineering firm(s) as required to define specific information which will be integral to the compounding success of each phase of the program. We will collaborate with all parties to adapt the Persons Services Corp. benchmarking procedure to the completion of your public transit facility.

Persons Services Corp. Benchmark Procedure:

- 1. Determine key benchmarks/milestones.
- 2. Define the benchmark and the expectation of completion.
- 3. Develop data collection methodology.
- 4. Collect data.
- 5. Analyze the data and identify deficiencies in the use of best practices and project management performance.
- 6. Identify reasons for deficiencies and execute corrective actions.
- 7. Develop an action plan (select best practices to reduce deficiencies).
- 8. Integrate best practices into the <u>construction project delivery</u> process.
- 9. Institutionalize benchmarking as part of a continuous improvement program.

C) COMPLAINT/CONFLICT RESOLUTION

Complaint resolution is taken very seriously by Persons Services Corp. and while we are proud of the consistently complimentary reviews we have received from our clients, we understand the necessity to have a complaint resolution plan in place prior to the beginning of a project. Firstly, our initial defense to complaint resolution is to mitigate all risks in the preconstruction phase. Persons Services Corp. will

work closely with the Architect and Engineering firm(s) to ensure that all avenues have been explored and thoroughly considered. PSC will ensure that any conflicts in relation to design practicality, constructability, budget, or scheduling are brought to the attention of the A/E firm and the City before moving forward. It is our goal to create a fully comprehensive and obtainable product plan before the construction phase can begin. With a well-executed risk mitigation effort, complaints/conflicts are vastly reduced. When a conflict does arrive, the matter will be addressed in a timely manner, identifying the issue, the concerns, potential resolutions for success, then collaborating with all stakeholders, a decision of proper course of action will be implemented.

D) QA/QC AND SAFETY

Persons Services Corp will implement their Quality Control Plan and Health & Safety Plan updated with project specific information, tasks, goals, and milestones. These plans will require adherence by all subcontractors. The Quality Control Plan will entail verification of materials used, materials testing when required, laboratory test results provided, samples provided when necessary, best methods and practices reviewed prior to work, and verification of work being performed utilizing best methods and practices. Our Safety Plan entails following all OSHA guidelines and regulations, educating and training personnel on a regular interval, monitoring and verifying adherence, daily notifications and reminders to ensure participation, resolution, and consequences for non-adherence.

E) PROJECT MANAGEMENT TECHNIQUES & CONTROLS

Persons Services Corp. (PSC) has a verifiable record of successful project delivery. Our experience managing projects includes work across diverse trades, each one serving as a complement to the requirements necessary to successfully manage projects put forth by the City of Hallandale Beach.

Our team has successfully completed sports complexes, playgrounds, exercise trails, and planned unit developments (PUD), as well as large-scale residential and commercial builds, community centers, commercial renovations, residential renovations, water treatment facilities, power plant upgrades, and underground utility infrastructure projects. I) CONTRACT EXECUTION

Upon notification of award of this contract, the PSC Team will begin the process of detailing milestones (KPIs), immediate and early decision tasks, material needs, logistics, communications plan, key stakeholders, change management plan, conflict resolution plan, and closeout procedures. PSC will review construction documents to identify the above items and to require a plan from the Developer and/or their GC, detailing how each will be addressed and mitigated. PSC will also begin the process of verifying constructability and code compliance of the proposed project during the review of the construction documents.

II) MOBILIZATION

Upon notice to proceed the PSC Team will begin the Mobilization process. This process consists of the following:

A. PERSONNEL DEPLOYMENT:

PSC Team will mobilize the management team.

B. OFFICE SET UP:

PSC Team will set up a local office in an area agreeable to the city and in close proximity to the construction site. This office will serve as our local construction deployment site. The office will house our local administration and serve as a daily meeting point with all personnel.

III) PRE-CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Working concurrently with mobilization, the PSC Team will begin the preconstruction process. This process includes the following activities. Many of the following activities will be performed simultaneously or with overlapping finish to start dates:

A. DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR INTRODUCTIONS:

The PSC Team will meet with the City and the architectural and engineering firm, to discuss PMP, KPI/Milestones, schedule, meeting times, agenda, safety, logistics, temporary facilities, traffic controls, materials & methods, and expectations.

B. LOGISTICS & MATERIALS

The PSC Team will work with the Developer Team to identify long lead item materials needing expedited ordering, material storage, and methods of construction. A plan will be developed, agreed upon by all parties, and adhered to throughout the project.

C. COST CONTROL:

The PSC Team will work with the Developer Team and the City regarding cost budget in order to implement cost controls. This includes a change management plan to control change orders. PSC will develop the cost control plan in agreement with all parties.

D. STAKEHOLDER COMMUNICATION:

The above plans are all part of and incorporated in the overall Project Management Plan that will be developed and implemented for each project. A communication plan will also be incorporated to include frequency and inclusion of Stakeholders to be informed.

E. SUBMITTALS/SHOP DRAWINGS/SPECIFICATIONS:

The PSC Team will implement a submittal plan and log. The Team will work closely with the Developer Team and A&E Team to ensure specifications are followed, methods and materials meet requirements, and proper codes are followed.

F. SUBCONTRACTORS:

The PSC Team will develop a list of subcontractors for each project and ensure that all safety and site requirements are followed. PSC will work with the Developer Team to identify subcontractors and require participation in frequent meetings.

IV) CONSTRUCTION PHASE:

A. PERMITTING:

The PSC Team will verify all permitting is in place prior to commencement of construction. The PSC Team will work closely with the Developer Team and assist where needed to expedite permits if required.

B. SITE VISIT/MONITORING:

PSC Team will monitor projects daily to ensure progress, quality, and safety. Daily reports will be issued to include narrative of the day's events as well as pictures of progress and/or issues/concerns. The PSC Team will meet with construction superintendents in charge and resolve issues or concerns, perform schedule reviews, and one-day and one-week "look aheads". The Team will monitor scope completion by itemizing tasks per schedule of values and record percent complete.

C. REPORTING:

Throughout the construction process the PSC Team CM will perform periodic inspections. The Team will circulate daily, weekly, and monthly reports. Daily reports will document progress/concerns/issues with narrative and photographic records. Weekly reports will be circulated to include a summary of daily events, a cost report, schedule report with modifications, and safety incident report. The monthly report will be a more detailed cost report with variance, % complete, billable items, and estimated cost to complete.

D. ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT:

The PSC Team includes our administrative and accounting support team in the home office. Safety, Quality, and Cost controls will be reviewed and monitored.

E. CLOSE OUT:

Upon acceptance of the project by the City, the PSC Team will implement our close-out process. This will include packaging all final documents including municipal approvals, final



as-built drawings, warranties, product data sheets, stat-up/commissioning instructions/reports, final cost reports, all recorded and progress documents, and all final sign offs.

F) PROGRAMS & TECHNOLOGY EMPLOYED

This also allows for document and photographic storage/management, daily reporting, cost management, and scope management.
