## **Proposed Legislation:**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 103 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "PARKS AND RECREATION", BY CREATING SECTION 103.04, ENTITLED "DESIGNATED CHILDREN PLAY AREAS", TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS RELATING TO PLAY AREAS WITHIN CITY PARKS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER PROVISION; A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

## Explanation:

This ordinance seeks to amend Chapter 103 of the Code of Ordinances, entitled "Parks and Recreation," by creating section 103.04 entitled "Designated Children Play Areas," and establish regulations relating to play areas within city parks.

Play areas for children are intended to furnish and provide age appropriate recreational play equipment and open space to accommodate the needs of children in the City who are supervised by parents, guardians, caretakers, or other appropriate adults. These play areas are not intended to be used by adults, except where adults are accompanying the children utilizing these play areas. In order to provide for the safest play areas for children and minors in the City of Hollywood, and to maximize play area equipment available for children and minors for whom the City's play equipment and play areas are specifically designed, the Police Chief and city staff have determined that is necessary to establish and post regulations and guidelines for these play areas.

With passage and approval of this Amendment, appropiate signage will be placed at the forty (40) designated children's play areas in the City's parks, reflecing the restrictions. Funding for the purchase of this signage is available and identified in the FY 2015 budget in account number 01.2042.00297.521.005214.
