

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Commission of the City of Hollywood, Florida, is advertising for sealed bids which shall be <u>submitted to the City Clerk's Office</u> (City Hall, 2600 Hollywood Blvd., Room 221) of the City of Hollywood, Florida, **until 10:00 a.m.**, local time, **May 22, 2015**. On **May 22, 2015 at 11:00 a.m.**, the bids will be opened and read publicly in the Department of Public Utilities, Engineering and Construction Services Conference Room at 1621 N. 14th Avenue, Building A, Hollywood, Florida.

A <u>mandatory</u> pre-bid conference will be held on April 24, 2015 at 10:00 a.m., at the Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant, located at 1621 N. 14th Avenue Hollywood, Florida 33021, ECSD Conference Room

The Bid Package and Contract documents may also be obtained, upon request, at a cost of \$500.00 from the Department of Public Utilities - ECSD at 1621 North 14th Avenue in Hollywood. Technical assistance shall be submitted in writing to the Project Manager, Wilhelmina Montero, P.E., wmontero@hollywoodfl.org.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Security in an amount no less than ten percent (10%) of the bid amount. Said security shall be in the form of a Certified Check or Cashier's Check on a solvent National or State Bank, or a bid bond executed by the Bidder and a qualified Surety, satisfactory and payable to the City of Hollywood, Florida.

A Cone of Silence is in effect with respect to this bid. The Cone of Silence prohibits certain communications between potential vendors and the City. For further information, please refer to Section 30.15(F) of the City's Code of Ordinances.

The City of Hollywood is strongly committed to ensuring the participation of local Hollywood vendors in the procurement of goods and services. For additional information about the City's Local Preference Ordinance, visit www.hollywoodfl.org.

It will be the Bidder's sole responsibility to <u>hand-deliver</u> or <u>mail</u> his/her proposal to the City Clerk's Office at City Hall on or before the closing hour and date for the receipt of bids as noted above.

The City Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive informalities and to accept or reject all or any part of any bid, as they may deem to be in the best interest of the City of Hollywood, Florida.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. PREPARATION OF BIDS:

Bids must be submitted on the separate and enclosed **BIDDING PACKAGE** forms, which shall be completed **by typewriter** or legibly handwritten in ink. The Bid price of each item on the form must be stated in words and numerals; in case of a conflict, words will take precedence. Where unit prices and extended totals are required, unit prices take precedence. Likewise, discrepancies between the indicated sum of any column of figures and the correct sum thereof will be resolved in favor of the correct sum.

If the Bid is made by an individual, he must sign his name therein and state his address. If the Bid is made by a firm or partnership, its name and address must be stated, as well as the name and address of each member of the firm or partnership. Bids by corporations must be signed by an authorized corporate officer (accompanied by evidence of authority to sign) and the corporate seal must be affixed and attested by the Secretary or an Assistant Secretary of the corporation. The corporate address and state of incorporation shall be shown below the signature. When the state of incorporation is other than Florida, proof of registry with Florida must be attached.

2. RECEIPT AND OPENING OF BIDS:

The separate **BIDDING PACKAGE** consisting of the PROPOSAL, PROPOSAL BID FORM, APPROVED BID BOND, TRENCH SAFETY FORM, INFORMATION REQUIRED FROM BIDDERS AND LIST OF SUBCONTRACTORS AND/OR MATERIAL SUPPLIERS shall be completed, signed and sealed as required and must be delivered in a sealed, opaque envelope, addressed to the City Clerk of Hollywood, Florida, by the time called for in the Notice to Bidders and shall be properly identified on the face thereof.

Proposals will be publicly opened and immediately read aloud at the time and place designated in the Notice to Bidders. No proposal will be considered which is not based upon these Drawings and Specifications, or which contains any letter or written memorandum qualifying the same, or which is not properly made out and signed in writing by the Bidder.

3. PRE-BID CONFERENCE:

A **mandatory** Pre-bid Conference will be held at the Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant, Bldg A 1621 N. 14th Avenue, Hollywood, Florida 33019, ECSD Conference Room, on **Friday, April 24, 2015** at 10:00 AM. All Contractors planning to submit a bid <u>must</u> attend the meeting.

4. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:

The Contract Documents give the location and description of the work to be done under this Contract and estimated quantities of each item of work for which Bids are invited, the time in which the work must be completed, the amount of the Bid Guaranty, if any, and the date, time and place of the receipt and opening of the Bids.

5. EXAMINATION OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND SITE:

The Bidder is required to carefully examine the site of the work and the Contract Documents for the work contemplated. It will be assumed that the Bidder has investigated and is fully informed as to the requirements of the Contract Documents, laws, ordinances, codes and any other factors which may affect the performance of the work. Failure to be so informed will not relieve a successful Bidder of his obligation to furnish all material, equipment and labor necessary to carry out the provision of the Contract Documents and to complete the contemplated work for the consideration set forth in his Bid.

6. DIMENSIONS, QUANTITIES AND SUBSURFACE INFORMATION:

Dimensions, quantities and subsurface information supplied by the City are in no way warranted to indicate true amounts or conditions. Bidders/Contractors shall neither plead misunderstanding or deception, nor make claims against the City if the actual amounts, conditions or dimensions do not conform to those stated. Any "Outside" reports made available by the Engineer are neither guaranteed as to accuracy or completeness, nor a part of the Contract Documents.

7. ADDENDA - CHANGES WHILE BIDDING:

During the Bidding period, Bidders may be furnished addenda or bulletins for additions or alterations to the Plans or Specifications which shall be included in the work covered by the Proposal.

Any prospective Bidder in doubt as to the meaning of any part of the Drawings, Specifications or other Contract Documents may submit a written request to the Engineer for an interpretation. The Bidder submitting the request will be responsible for its prompt delivery. Any interpretation of the documents will be made by an addendum and a copy of such addendum will be mailed or delivered to each prospective Bidder who has received a set of documents. The City will not be responsible for any other explanations or interpretations of the proposed documents. ALL INQUIRES MUST BE RECEIVED, IN WRITING, BY THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD NO LATER THAN 4:00 P.M., MAY 1, 2015. ADDENDUM WILL BE ISSUED ON MAY 15, 2015.

8. BID GUARANTY:

A Bid Guaranty in the form of a Cashier's Check, Certified Check or Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and a qualified Surety in the amount of **10%** of the Bid is required for this project in accordance with the Notice to Bidders.

9. TRENCH SAFETY FORM:

The Trench Safety Form included in the Bid Documents must be completed and signed. Noncompliance with this requirement may invalidate the bid.

10. QUALIFICATIONS AND DISQUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS:

The Contract will be awarded only to a Bidder, who in the opinion of the Engineer, is fully

qualified to undertake the work. The City reserves the right before awarding the Contract to require a Bidder to submit such evidence of his qualifications as it may deem necessary and may consider any available evidence of his financial status, technical qualifications and other qualifications and abilities. Any one of the following causes, among others, may be considered as sufficient justification to disqualify a Bidder and reject his Bid:

- A. Submission of more than one Bid for the same work by an individual, firm, partnership or corporation under the same or different names.
- B. Evidence of collusion.
- C. Previous participation in collusive Bidding on work for the City of Hollywood, Florida.
- D. Submission of an unbalanced Bid in which the prices Bid for some items are out of proportion to the prices Bid for other items.
- E. Lack of competency. The Engineer may declare any Bidder ineligible, at any time during the process or receiving Bids or awarding the Contract, if developments arise which, in his opinion, adversely affects the Bidder's responsibility. The Bidder will be given an opportunity, by the Engineer, to present additional evidence before final action is taken.

As part of SECTION 00420, the Bidder:

- 1. Must provide as part of their references a minimum of three (3) similar projects performed within the last seven (7) years. The projects must be similar in nature and size. Resumes of individuals (especially Superintendent) performing the work must be provided. The Bidder must also state their proposed project manager by name and a list a minimum of two (2) similar projects managed by him/her with references along with his/her resume. Each project must be under a different contract. Only Bidders including their project manager with the capabilities and experience on similar projects will be considered qualified for bid consideration. Judgment of 'similar projects' is at the sole discretion of the City and Engineer. The successful Bidder cannot replace their project manager without providing a suitable replacement which is determined under the sole discretion of the City.
- 2. Must demonstrate extensive experience in public outreach, since the project(s) will take place in mostly residential areas.
- 3. Must provide proof of equipment ownership.
- 4. Shall have current or recent CONTINUING contract with a local municipality to perform similar work.
- F. Lack of responsibility as shown by past work judged by the Engineer from the standpoint of workmanship and progress.
- G. Uncompleted work for which the Bidder is committed by Contract, which is in the judgment of the Engineer, might hinder or prevent the prompt completion of work under this Contract.
- H. Being in arrears on any existing Contracts with the City, or any taxes, licenses or other monies due the City; in litigation with the City or having defaulted on a previous contract with the City.

12. LIFE AND WITHDRAWAL OF BID:

All Bids shall remain open for 90 days after the day of the Bid opening, however, the Engineer may, at his sole discretion, release any Bid and return the Bid Guaranty prior to that date. Any Bid may be modified or withdrawn prior to the time scheduled for the opening of Bids.

13. REJECTION OF IRREGULAR BIDS:

Bids will be considered irregular and may be rejected if they show omissions, alterations of form, additions not called for, conditions, limitations, unauthorized alternate Bids or other irregularities of any kind.

14. BIDDING ERRORS:

If after the opening of bids, a Bidder claims an error and requests to be relieved of the Award, or the Engineer believes that an error may have been made then, the Bidder shall present his work sheets and supplier quotations to the Engineer for verification. This information shall be presented on the same day as the bid opening or if the opening is in the afternoon then on the following business day. When the Engineer has suspected an error and requires the documents, Bidder's failure to produce them within the time specified shall make the Bidder non-responsive and thereby eligible for disqualification. Award may then be made to the next lowest responsive, responsible Bidder, or the work may be re-advertised or it may be performed by City forces, as the Commission desires.

15. AWARD OF CONTRACT:

The City Commission reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, or any part of any Bid, to waive any informality in any Bid, or to re-advertise for all or any part of the work contemplated. If Bids are found to be acceptable by the City Commission, written notice of award will be given to the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder.

16. EXECUTION OF CONTRACT:

The Bidder to whom the Contract is awarded shall, within ten days of the date of award, execute and deliver three (3) copies of the following to the Engineer.

- A. The Contract
- B. Performance and Payment Bond
- C. Evidence of required Insurance
- D. Proof of authority to execute the Contract
- E. Proof of authority to execute the Bond on behalf of the Awardee
- F. List of Subcontractors, estimated Contract Value for each and proof that such subcontractors possess all required Federal, State, County and/or municipality licenses, including but not limited to certified of competency and occupational license

The above documents must be furnished, executed and delivered before the Contract will be executed by the City. The Contract shall not be binding upon the City until it has been executed by the City and a copy of such fully executed Contract is delivered to the Contractor.

17. FAILURE TO EXECUTE CONTRACT, BID GUARANTY FORFEITED:

Should the Bidder to whom the Contract has been awarded refuse or fail to complete the requirements of Article 16 above within ten (10) days after Notice of Award, the additional time in days (including weekends) required to CORRECTLY complete the documents will be deducted, in equal amount, from the Contract Time, or the City may elect to revoke the Award. In the same manner as Article 13, the Bid Guaranty of any Bidder failing to execute the awarded Contract shall be retained by the City and the Contract awarded as the Commission desires.

18. GUARANTY OF FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT:

A Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each equal to 100 percent of the total Bid will be required of the Awardee. The Bond must be written through a company licensed to do business in the State of Florida and be rated at least "A", Class X, in the latest edition of "Best's Key Rating Guide", published by A.M. Best Company. As per Florida Statute Section 255.05, the Contractor shall be required to record the payment and performance bonds in the public records of Broward County.

19. INSURANCE:

Bidder must satisfy all insurance requirements as set forth in the Supplementary and General Conditions.

The insurance policy shall not contain any exceptions that would exclude coverage for risks that can be directly or reasonably related to the scope of goods or services in this bid/proposal. A violation of this requirement at any time during the term, or any extension thereof shall be grounds for the immediate termination of any contract entered in to pursuant to this bid/proposal. In order to show that this requirement has been met, along with an insurance declaration sheet demonstrating the existence of a valid policy of insurance meeting the requirements of this bid/proposal, the successful proposer must submit a signed statement from insurance agency of record that the full policy contains no such exception.

20. QUALIFICATIONS:

At the time of submission of the bid, Bidder must possess, and be able to provide City, any and all required Federal, State, County and/or municipal licenses, including but not limited to certificates of competency and occupational licenses. Moreover, upon receipt of the Award of the Contract, Bidder must provide proof of valid licensing for all subcontractors and/or material suppliers hired by the Contractor as set forth in Article 16 above.

When the Bidder is a Joint Venture, in order to satisfy the construction licensing requirements one member of a Joint Venture must hold a valid state certificate as well as the appropriate county and city license. The Contractor shall be held responsible for assurance that all subcontractors and/or material suppliers hired by the Contractor have the appropriate state certificate and licenses.

21. PERMITS:

The Contractor and Subcontractors must obtain Building Permits required for all work covered

under this Contract as well as any other permit required by any other regulatory agency. The Master Building Permit required by the City shall be obtained by the Contractor but paid for by the City. Any and all other permits required by the City, County, State of Florida, or any other regulatory agency shall be obtained and paid for by the Contractor.

The Contractor or Subcontractors shall also be responsible to call for all inspections as required in Section 105 (Inspections) of the latest edition of the Florida Building Code.

NOTICE OF IMPOSITION OF CONE OF SILENCE

On April 10, 2015 the City of Hollywood, Florida Department of Public Utilities issued the following:

Project No. 13-5119; Water Main Replacement Program- Hollywood Boulevard to Sheridan Street Between Federal Highway and the Intracoastal Waterway

<u>Project Scope</u>: The project consists of two water main improvement projects and a stormwater system improvement project. The water main projects consist of approximately 8,000 linear feet of 12 to 24-inch water mains along the east side of Federal Highway (US1) to replace an existing 8-inch water main and approximately 98,000 linear feet of existing potable water mains being replaced ranging from 4 to 24-inches from east of Federal Highway (US1), bounded by Sheridan Street, Hollywood Blvd., and the Intracoastal Waterway as well as water main stub outs, services, meter reconnections/relocations, new fire hydrants and roadway restoration as shown on the plans. Additionally, drainage improvements within the North lake Neighborhood will be constructed as shown on separate drainage plans.

Pursuant to Section 30.15(F) of the Code of Ordinances, a Cone of Silence has been imposed on the items set forth above. The Cone of Silence will continue until the City awards or approves a contract, votes to reject all bids or responses, or otherwise takes action which ends the solicitation. If the City Commission refers the item back to the City Manager and staff for further review, the Cone of Silence shall remain in effect until an award is made, a contract is approved, or the City Commission takes any other action which ends the solicitation.

The following is a summary of the key items discussed during the meeting held on April 24, 2015 at 10:00 AM

1. Introduction

All attendees must sign the attached sign-in sheet and introduce themselves during the meeting.

All bidders in attendance at the mandatory Pre-bid Meeting signed the attendance sheet in order to be considered responsive. The Pre-bid Meeting Summary and signed attendee list will be provided with Addendum No. 1. The City of Hollywood is the owner and operator of the facilities. The City's Project Manager is Wilhelmina Montero, P.E., M.S., Project Manager

Ms. Montero presented an overview of the project and stated that the project consists of three specific projects which the Contractors are to include in their bids; the first project is from Sheridan Street to Hollywood Blvd., east of Federal Highway and to the Intracoastal, the second project which is the East side of Federal Highway, and the third project which consists of City drainage improvements. She further stated that all bids are to be submitted for all portions of these projects.

2. Scope of Project

This construction work consists of the replacement of water pipes within the project limits, water meter relocations, fire hydrant replacement, water service reconnection, pavement restoration, pavement marking and striping, etc. for a fully operational system. Also, drainage improvements are included as part of this project. The budget estimate for the construction of this project is \$10,000,000.00 including owner's contingency and permit allowance.

The City stated that the Contingency included in the Bid Form is explicitly for City use and requires written approval prior to any additional commencement of work.

3. Bidding Document Description

The City reviewed the bidding requirements and provided specific dates to be met as indicated above. The project completion time for substantial and final completion were provided, the work hours per City requirements stated and it indicated that permit specific work hours must be followed, the specifications stated as needing to be followed and the project Drawings reiterated that they encompass three sets of plans including the East side of Federal Highway, the project east of Federal Highway to the Intracoastal Waterway and North Lake Drainage Improvements (Phase 3).

Bidders are required to confirm that they have a complete Contract Document package if they printed the bid documents from advertisement website.

The City stated that the Contractors are to ensure that they have a complete set of the required Contract Documents package which includes the above referenced sections being reviewed, completed and submitted to the City.

The City stated that all bids must be delivered in sealed packages containing all the required forms, affidavits, addenda, etc. If any of the required documents are missing and the packaged is not submitted sealed, the bid will be rejected and the bidder declared non-responsive.

4. Design and Specs Comments and Highlights

Tetra Tech

Tetra Tech was introduced by the City to review key project specifics and items that the Contractor is to note and ensure that they include in their bid packages and costs.

- Bid Set includes 3 sets of plans 13-5119, Federal Highway East Side, North Lake Drainage Improvements Phase 3.
 - The Contractor's are to include all costs for all three plan sets in their bids.
- Geotextile present along Polk Street and Tyler Street from N 14th Ave to N 7th Ave Tetra Tech stated that there is existing geotextile present within the project limits and that the limits of the geotextile are not fully known, but are known to be on Tyler and Polk Streets. The Contractor is to remove and replace the existing geotextile fabric and follow the technical specifications, plan detail and information provided by the manufacturer in the Appendix.

Organic soils and groundwater Tetra Tech stated that the approximate area of organic soils is shown per the geotechnical report and that the Contractor will be required to remove organic soils within the pipe trench. In addition, Tetra Tech stated that dewatering requirements need to be maintained for groundwater and groundwater discharge.

- Stainless Steel nuts, bolts and restraining rods

 Tetra Tech stated that stainless Steel 316 (SS 316) is required east of Federal
 Highway for all nuts, bolts and restraining rods, including bolts for fire hydrant
 fittings, etc. due to highly corrosive soil conditions. All mechanical joint fittings
 shall require the use of SS 316 and also be wrapped in polyethylene.
- Varying pavement thickness

 Tetra Tech stated that there may be varying pavement thicknesses within the project limits. In addition, that FDOT has a different requirement for pavement restoration/reconstruction as stated in the Bid Documents and permits included in the Appendices. Contractors are to take into consideration the potential of varying pavement thicknesses for roadway reconstruction costs in their bids.
- Taps under water

 Tetra Tech stated that there may be varying groundwater table elevations requiring dewatering and taps to be made under water. The project's technical specifications and requirements are to be reviewed and followed in these cases.
- Contaminated Sites Tetra Tech stated that there is evidence of contaminated soils within the project limits. –Location information based on the Broward County website has been included in the Appendix for Contractor reference; however, it was further stated that the latest updated information from Broward County's website should be reviewed by the Contractors and evaluated for determining their bid costs.
- Permitting: DOH, FDOT, COH
 The City stated that the City Building Department permit is to be finalized and obtained by the Contractor. Tetra Tech stated that the DOH and FDOT Utility permits for utility work and water main extension have been secured for the east side of Federal Highway to the Intracoastal Waterway project and that the east side of Federal Highway FDOT and DOH permits had been submitted and approvals are pending. These permits will be included in the Addendum.
- Relocation of Meters

 Tetra Tech stated that the Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining any plumbing permits for each property for rerouting/reconnecting of water services to relocated meters inside private property and obtain signatures for "Right of Entry Permit and Temporary Construction Easement" forms (as included in the Appendix of Bid Documents) from the property owners prior to commencing any work within private property.
- Intersections of Federal Hwy. and Sheridan St. and N. 14th Ave and Sheridan St. Tetra Tech stated that the above two intersections involve replacement of the existing 24" PCCP with 24" DIP and that coordination with the manufacturer/supplier of the 24" PCCP, Hanson, will be necessary.
- Staging
 Tetra Tech stated that the Contractor is to secure staging areas for materials, equipment, suitable and unsuitable excavation material, etc. which is to be at their own expense.
- Utilities to be protected and field verified Tetra Tech stated that there are several large facilities present within project limits from FP&L and AT&T including ducts, sanitary sewer, force mains, brine mains, reclaimed mains, stormwater, etc. that are also larger diameter and need to be field verified, protected and maintained. Protection was emphasized due to prior mains that had been impacted by Contractors during construction with the City.

Maintenance of Traffic

Tetra Tech stated that the Contractor must submit MOT plans for approval to both the City of Hollywood and FDOT prior to working within their respective rights-ofway.

FDOT working hours

Tetra Tech stated that all permit conditions, including working hours, are to be met for project limits within FDOT right-of-way.



Item 18: General Information:

Work during restricted hours and/or night work, per FDOT requirements, is anticipated as being required. The Contractor is to include these costs in their bids. No additional compensation by the City will be provided for restricted hours, night work, lane closures or MOT efforts, etc. to meet FDOT's requirements.

Item 19: Bidder Questions:

1. Project soil borings contain numerous references to the presence of Muck throughout the project site extending through depths ranging from 1' – 13' below the ground surface. Spec section 02222-3.09 A & B places the responsibility of removal and replacement of this material through a point 2' below the outside bottom of the pipe trench as an incidental cost to the contractor. Further excavation may be ordered by the Engineer if deemed necessary. Given the variable depth range of these soil conditions and subjectivity of the Engineer's judgement, contractors will be forced to err on the high side when blending these incidental costs into unit prices for water main construction.

We believe that the City would be better served if a unit price were included in the schedule of values to pay for each cubic yard removed from the site (Truck Cubic Yards) and respectfully request that this be considered. Load tickets can be used to validate cubic yards removed. The cost of replacement material would be included in this unit price.

RESPONSE: See revised Specification Sections 02220 and 02222 which require 2-feet of unsuitable soils to be removed below the pipe trench. City standard details on Sheet C-202 have also been updated accordingly. The removal of the muck shall be quantified accordingly and included in the linear foot price of the piping.

2. Spec section 02210-3.10B states, "As directed by the Engineer, over excavate unacceptable materials below the foundation subgrade or two feet below the pipe to be installed. Backfill the over excavation with compacted screened gravel or crushed stone wrapped with nonwoven geotextile fabric. In no case shall the screened gravel be placed directly

on the exposed subgrade prior to placing the geotextile fabric". Here again, the variable depth range of over-excavation and subjectivity of the Engineer's judgement will force contractors to err on the high side when blending these incidental costs into unit prices for water main construction.

The above is not shown in any details and is not consistent with Spec 02222 requirements, which are specifically referenced in trench details shown on Plan Sheet C-202. Will the described wrapped bedding be utilized anywhere on this project and if so, we respectfully request that a unit price be established in the schedule of values?

RESPONSE: Section 02210 has been deleted from the specifications.

3. Given the volume of potential unsuitable material and the breadth of the project, staging areas should be considered by the City to assist contractors during cycling of spoils. Staging areas will allow for removal of unsuitable material from the residential areas (Streets, Swales, Vacant Lots), which should reduce the number of complaints and inconvenience to area residents. The park located at the end of Johnson Street near the ICW has been successfully utilized on past City projects and should be suitable for this project due to its proximity to the work. Other more central areas should also be considered.

The City of Hollywood will provide an area within RESPONSE: Holland Park, located at the eastern end of Johnson Street, for use by the Contractor, solely for the purpose of temporary storage of organic soils excavated as part of this project. Coordination with the City will be required for access and hours of use. The area within Holland Park will be approximately by 100 feet x 170 feet and will be located within an existing parking lot. The Contractor is to provide a screened and secured fence for this portion of the parking lot with a silt barrier at the bottom of the fence. In addition, at the completion of the project, the Contractor shall mill 1-inch of pavement within the temporary storage area limits, resurface the milled area with 1-inch of asphalt pavement meeting City standards and provide new pavement markings to match the existing markings. The CMP was installed many years ago and is in very fragile condition due to sa Itwater exposure, tidal erosion, joint separation, etc. Our experience tells us that the drainage pipe will either be damaged beyond re-use once exposed or the City will desire to replace sections as may be required to ensure that no failure will occur once the roadway is reconstructed. We believe there may be value for the City if unit prices were established to remove and replace drainage pipe of varying diameters, construct concrete collars to join old and new drainage pipe and for connections to existing basins where drainage pipe cannot be salvaged and must be replaced to the nearest structure.
