A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A ONE
YEAR ACTION PLAN AND PROJECTED USE OF FUNDS
FOR FEDERAL PROGRAM YEAR 2015/2016.

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood has been designated as an entitlement city by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, HUD has mandated that all entitlement cities submit a Consolidated Plan, including a One Year Action Plan, which governs housing and community development needs within the jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood has utilized U.S. Census data, locally adopted planning documents, and its public participation process to formulate a Five Year Consolidated Plan and One Year Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2014, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2014-229 which adopted a five year consolidated plan for federal program years 2014/2015-2018/2019; and

WHEREAS, through its citizens participation process, the Community Development Advisory Board (CDAB) has made recommendations which are reflected in the One Year Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, both the City Commission and the CDAB are committed to priorities which give maximum benefit to low and moderate income families, preserve the quality of the City's housing, and aid in the elimination of slum and blight; and

WHEREAS, the projected use of funds contained herein pertain to Federal Program Year 2015/2016 for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and the Home Investment Partnership Act (HOME) Grant; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), has allocated for the City of Hollywood \$1,064,757.00 of CDBG funds and \$355,581.00 of Home investment Partnership Act (HOME) funds; and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2015, the CDAB met to review and evaluate the proposed One Year Action Plan and the potential use activities eligible for funding for Fiscal Year 2015/2016 and have forwarded a unanimous recommendation of approval to the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the following activities represent the unanimous recommendations of the CDAB for Fiscal Year 2015/2016 which will be subject to City Commission approval after a public hearing process:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby approves, adopts, and authorizes the submission by the appropriate City Officials, of the attached One Year Action Plan for program year 2015/2016 including all assurances and certifications attached hereto, to the U.S. Department of HUD governing the CDBG and HOME programs for the federal program year commencing on October 1, 2015, together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

Section 2: That it hereby certifies that the City will comply with all applicable federal laws, regulations, policies, guidelines and requirements with respect to CDBG and HOME which include all assurances and certifications.

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Section 3: That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute the One Year Action Plan submission, all necessary certifications, and is hereby designated to be the authorized representative of the City to act in connection with the Plan and to provide any additional information as may be required.

Section 4: The City Manager, or his designee, is further authorized and directed to assume the status of the responsible federal official of the National Environmental Policy Act insofar as the provisions of this act apply to this application.

Section 5: That the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed to consent, on behalf of the City and himself, to accept jurisdiction of the federal courts for the purpose of enforcement of his responsibilities as a designated federal official.

Section 6: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
