Per our telecon yesterday, we can confirm that Chart Industries is the only existing U.S. manufacturer of brazed aluminum heat exchangers of the type required for the COH replacement nitrogen superheater.

At the time the COH cryogenic plant was built, there were two U.S. manufacturers, Trane and Stewart Warner. Trane, thru acquisition, became part of Chart Industries and Stewart Warner went out of business and sold its manufacturing assets to a Chinese company.

There are several other manufacturers of brazed aluminum heat exchangers worldwide but Chart is the only remaining manufacturer in the U.S.
