Severe cracking of the walls and revisions to the operating levels within the neighboring clarifier trough in order to meet new regulatory requirements has provided a pathway for multiple leaks to penetrate the interior of the pump station. In addition, electrical and mechanical equipment has reached the end of its useful life and requires replacement.
