A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED CONTRACT BETWEEN ALLSTATE TOWER, INC. AND THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD FOR STRUCTURAL UPGRADES TO THE SELF-SUPPORTING COMMUNICATIONS TOWER BEHIND THE POLICE BUILDING, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$54,014.00

WHEREAS, the Police Department has determined that CCTV and Automated License Reader (ALPR) Cameras serve as a deterrent to crime and can provide critical information in resolving crimes; and

WHEREAS, as part of the CCTV Project, installation of additional equipment on the Communications Tower is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department, through the use of a consultant, determined that the existing Self-Supporting Communications Tower at the Police Building is insufficient to meet the existing requirements of the Florida Building Code; and

WHEREAS, construction documents and specifications to make structural upgrades to the Communications Tower were prepared by the Consultant and the Notice to Bidders was advertised online via BidSync on August 4, 2015; and

WHEREAS, these construction documents and specifications were viewed by 46 vendors on BidSync and 14 vendors downloaded the Project Manual and drawings; and

WHEREAS, through receipt of the City's bid specifications for this project, the vendors have been provided with a copy of the City's contract, including the terms and conditions contained therein; and

WHEREAS, six (6) bids were received and publicly opened at 10:00 AM on August 25, 2015, and the responsive bids were as follows:

WHEREAS, Allstate Tower, Inc, the lowest responsible bidder did not acknowledge receipt of the Addendum in reference to a typo, and once the vendor reviewed the Addendum, it was confirmed that the vendor's bid remained the same as it was not affected by the Addendum; and

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed the low bid and determined that the bid submitted by Allstate Tower Inc. was, a responsive and responsible bid, and have recommended the award of the bid to Allstate Tower, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$54,014.00; and

WHEREAS, this project was approved in the FY 2015 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and funding is available in account no. 34.2015.15500.521.006301;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City Officials, of the attached contract between Allstate Tower, Inc., and the City of Hollywood, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

Section 2: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
