This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to enter into and execute agreements between Lewis, Longman & Walker, P.A. and the City of Hollywood for the provision of legal services to the Board of Trustees of the Employees' Retirement Fund. Previously, pursuant to Resolution R-2012-388, adopted and approved by the City Commission on December 19, 2012, approved an agreement with Lewis, Longman & Walker for a three-year term at the estimated annual cost of \$41,500. The City's Code of Ordinances in §38.40(C)(2) exempts from the competitive bid and competitive proposal requirements of the Purchasing Ordinance contracts for professional services.

It is estimated that the cost for all legal services provided by Lewis, Longman & Walker, P.A. in FY 2015 will not exceed \$100,000. Funding for legal services to be provided by
