This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to enter into and execute a grant award agreement and accept Maximizing Out of School Time (MOST) program funding provided by the 2016 Children's Services Council of Broward Country in support of and in order to conduct four (4) youth summer camps and one (1) after school program during the 2015 – 2016 fiscal year. Previously, pursuant to Resolution

R-2013-322, adopted and approved by the City Commission on November 6, 2013, the City through its Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts executed an agreement between the City and the Children's Services Council to receive funding from the Council's 2014 Children's Services Council (CSC) Maximizing Out of School Time (MOST) Year-Round grant program to conduct summer and after school programs in the City. The grant agreement contained a provision for the renewal of the agreement and the annual funding of the MOST year-round program. This Resolution authorizes the City to agree to renew the grant funding agreement for the third of four annual renewals to run from October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016. The 2015 - 2016 grant funding award to be received by the City will be in the amount of \$489,362.00 with the City required to make an in-kind match valued at \$70,251 consisting of staff services to operate the programs.
