Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to approve the attached blanket purchase order and to increase the annual estimated expenditure from \$53,466.70 to \$109,000.00. The additional increase is due to the operational needs frequency of two (2) loads per year. The term of the agreement is March 11, 2016 through March 10, 2017 and is the final renewal of the initial contract.

The initial contract was through the City of Pompano Beach, Bid number E-25-14, beginning March 11, 2014 through March 10, 2015 with two (2) one (1) year renewals allowable. The City of Hollywood Purchasing Ordinance Section 38.40 (C) (5) allows procurement without formal procedures when acting through other approved governmental Page 2 BIS 16-102 File TMP-2016-048

entities. On June 18, 2014 the Hollywood City Commission passed and adopted Resolution R-2014-165 authorizing the initial contract.

On March 4, 2015 the Hollywood City Commission passed and adopted Resolution R-2015-055 authorizing the first one (1) year renewal.

On January 26, 2016 the City of Pompano Beach administratively approved the contract with Nalco Company for the second and final one (1) year renewal period which will allow the City of Hollywood to continue purchasing through bid E-25-14.

There is adequate funding available in the FY 2016 budget from Public Utilities, Water Treatment account number 42.4011.00000.536.005233 – Chemical Supplies. Funding for expenditures to be included in the Fiscal Year 2017 will be requested as part of the department's fiscal year's operating budget subject to the approval of the City Commission.

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
