Explanation:

The Department of Public Utilities has identified the need to replace several flow meters at its Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant. The flow meters are sold exclusively by AWC Incorporated of Altamonte Springs, Florida. The City of Hollywood's Purchasing Ordinance 38.40(C)(3) allows sole-source supplies and services, such as unique, patented or franchised supplies or services, to be exempt from the competitive bid requirements.

Administration recommends issuing an Purchase Order to AWC Incorporated in the amount of \$64,400.

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On November 18, 2015, the City Commission adopted R-2015-345 which continued the appropriation for previously approved Capital Projects from FY 15 to FY 16. Funds are available in account # 42.4000.86532.536.006302.
