

When a building or structure is unsafe, it has become deficient in adequate facilities for means of egress, constitutes a fire or windstorm hazard, or illegal or improper use, occupancy or maintenance, or does not comply with the minimum standards of the housing code. An unsightly condition includes lack of paint, unkempt lawns, accumulation of debris, abandoned vehicles, etc., and are to be handled by code enforcement.

3.) Once a notice is posted on an unsafe structure by the Building Official, how many occupants are allowed to enter the structure?

No persons are to enter the residence without permission from the Building Official.

- 4.) Can construction work that has commenced without a building permit be deemed unsafe?
- FBC 116. 1.2 Incomplete buildings or structures commenced without a permit or a permit that has expired, shall be deemed unsafe.
- 5.) What is the significance of the code requiring a citizen with experience and background in social problems to sit on the Unsafe Structures Board?

Citizens with experience in social problems are able to assist a homeowner by directing them to any available social services such as the Red Cross, Shelters, or other social services.

Affordable Housing Advisory Committee - Questions*

- 1) In my opinion the greatest challenge to keeping housing affordable in Hollywood figuring out a way to keep new builds affordable while maintaining aesthetic appeal.
